THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY PLASTIC CONTROL (AMENDMENT) BILL, 2021 (ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 6 OF 2021)

Hon. John Muthiga: Thank you Madam Speaker. The Nairobi City County Plastic Control (Amendment) Bill, 2021, Assembly Bill No. 6 of 2021 underwent First Reading on 15th June 2021 and thereafter committed to the Sectoral Committee on Environment and Natural Resources for scrutiny and reporting to the assembly.

Madam Speaker, the committee is aware that the Bill has been scheduled for the Second Reading today. The Committee during its day to day engagements with its key stakeholders discovered significant emerging issues that needed to be factored in the report of the same Bill. The Committee observed that such issues are so crucial that they are cornerstone in the implementation if the Bill will be enacted into law.

Madam Speaker, in this regard therefore, the Committee seeks your indulgence in extension of time until Thursday 23rd September 2021 when the Committee will lay its report to enable the Second Reading of the said Bill. This will provide an opportunity for the Committee to include key recommendations in the report that will enable smooth operationization once the Bill is enacted into law.
