I. NOTICE is given that the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Culture and Community Services intends to move the following amendments to the Nairobi City County Betting, Lotteries and Gaming Bill, 2020, (Assembly Bill No. 3 of 2020) at the COMMITTEE STAGE: -

CLAUSE 1

THAT, Clause 1 be amended by deleting the numeric "2020" and substituting with the numeric "2021" thereof.

LONG TITLE

THAT, the Long Title be amended by deleting the numeric **"2020"** and substituting with the numeric **"2021"** thereof.

CLAUSE 2

THAT, Clause 2 of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) By deleting the word 'minor" and substituting it with the word 'child'

CLAUSE 5 (1) (e)

THAT, Clause 5 (1) (e) of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) By inserting the words **'and with 5 years' experience'** immediately after the word 'conversant'

CLAUSE 14 (g)

THAT, Clause 14(g) of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) By deleting the word 'repeated (b)' and replacing it with the words 'Enforce measures to ensure responsible gambling'

CLAUSE 17(2)

THAT Clause 17 (2) of the Bill be amended as follows; -

 By deleting the words 'to a fine not exceeding one hundred thousand shillings or to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months, or both' and substituting therefore with the words 'as per Part X of this Act'

CLAUSE 32 (1)

THAT Clause 32 (1) of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) by deleting the word **'proceeds'** and substituting therefore with the word **'winnings'**

CLAUSE 48 (1) (a)

THAT Clause 48 (1) (a) of the Bill be amended as follows; -

i. by deleting the word **'minor'** and substituting therefore with the word **'child'**

THAT Clause 52 of the bill be amended as follows; - NEW SUB-CLAUSES

(i) by inserting the following new sub-clauses immediately after subclause 2 as follows; -

'52 (3) The County Executive Committee Member for Finance shall appoint the administrator of the Fund' '52 (4) The administrator of the Fund shall allocate 1.5% of the fund for administrative expenses'

by inserting the following new Clauses immediately after Clause
 52 as follows; -

NEW CLAUSE

Annual Budget and Estimates "52 A (I) At least three months before the commencement of each financial year, the Board shall cause to be prepared budget estimates of the Fund for that year.

(2) The Board shall approve the annual estimates at least ninety days before the commencement of the financial year to which they relate and, once approved, the sum provided in the estimates shall be submitted to the County Executive Committee Member for final approval.

(3) No expenditure shall be incurred for the purposes of the Board except in accordance with the annual estimates approved under subsection (3), or in exceptional circumstances, in accordance with an authorization of the Board given with prior written approval of the county executive committee member.

NEW CLAUSE

of 52 B (1) The Board shall cause to be kept proper books of accounts and records of the Fund.

(2) The accounts and financial statements and records of the Board shall be audited and reported upon in accordance with provisions of the Public Audit Act

CLAUSE 55

THAT, Clause 55 of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) by inserting the words 'for Finance' immediately after the word 'member'

II. The Assembly resolved on Tuesday, 9th February, 2021 as follows: -

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 103(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on **Bills** sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party be limited as follows:- A maximum of forty five (45) minutes for the Mover, in moving and fifteen minutes (15) in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee (if the Bill is not sponsored by the relevant Committee), and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each (if the Bill is not sponsored by either of them); and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
