NOTICES

I. NOTICE is given that Hon. Waithera Chege, MCA intends to move the following amendments to the Nairobi City County Betting, Lotteries and Gaming (Amendment) Bill, 2021, at the Committee Stage: -

LONG TITLE

THAT, the Long Title be amended by deleting the numeric "2021" and substituting with the numeric "2022" thereof.

CLAUSE 1

THAT, Clause 1 be amended by deleting the numeric "2021" and substituting with the numeric "2022" thereof.

II. The Assembly resolved on Thursday, 10th February, 2022 as follows: -

Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on **Bills NOT** sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party be limited as follows:- A maximum of three hours and thirty minutes, with not more than thirty (30) minutes for the Mover, in moving and ten (10) minutes in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
