THAT, aware that sufficient security and effective transport system have a significant contribution to the economy of a country; further aware that boda boda transport have expedited the efficiency of transportation in Kenya and more so in Nairobi City County; deeply concerned that the use of motorcycles within the City has contributed to the increase in road accidents, traffic snarl-ups and crimes; noting that some criminals use motorbikes to commit crimes and flee from crime scene; this Assembly urges the County Government to develop guideline or regulations requiring all boda boda operators to register with saccos for identification of motorcycles which will reduce the dynamics in the transport and security sectors.

NOTICE

The Assembly resolved on Wednesday, February 19, 2014 as follows:-

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any **Motion** including a Special motion, be limited in the following manner:- A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
