## **NOTICE**

**The Assembly resolved on Wednesday, February 19, 2014 as follows:-**

**THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4) , this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any **Motion** including a Special motion, be limited in the following manner:- A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
