THAT, aware that commercial sex work in Nairobi City County has been on the rise over the years; **FURTHER AWARE** that commercial sex work has become prevalent in most Sub-Counties and Wards in the County; **DEEPLY CONCERNED** that Section 153 and 154 of the Penal Code (Chapter 63 of the Laws of Kenya) prohibits men and women from living wholly or partly on earnings or from soliciting through commercial sex work; **FURTHER CONCERNED** that implementation of the said provisions of the penal code remains unproductive; **NOTING** that the unlawful practice is today happening rampantly and openly within our communities without repercussions on the offenders as provided for in law; this Assembly urges the County Executive to move with speed and robustly enforce the provisions of the law to deter commercial sex work in the County.

N O T I C E S

The Assembly resolved on Tuesday, September 3, 2017 as follows:-

- I. **THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 103(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any **Motion**, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner:- A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
