

**THAT,** aware that Article 174 of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 states that one of the objects of devolution is to promote social and economic development and the provision of proximate, easily accessible services throughout the Country, enhance checks and balances and the separation of powers; further aware that Article 185 (3) of the Constitution states that a County Assembly while respecting the principle of the separation of powers, may exercise oversight over the County Executive Committee and any other County Executive organs; concerned that the County Assembly has experienced challenges in getting vital information from the County Executive on different matters such as implementation of various proposed projects, motions; noting that most of the County projects in various Wards have stalled thus hindering efficient service delivery to Nairobi City County residents; this Assembly urges the County Executive to establish a County Liaison Office that will act as a centre of information between the County Legislature and the Executive in the implementation of the County Assembly resolutions.

# <u>NOTICES</u>

#### I. Assembly resolved on Wednesday, February 15, 2017 as follows:-

**THAT,** notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any Motion, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner:- A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
