## 8. \*. MOTION – (Hon. Elizabeth Manyala, MCA)

THAT, aware that Article 26 (1) of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 provides that every person has the right to life; Further Article 53 (2) of the Constitution states that a child's best interests are of paramount importance in every matter concerning the child; concerned that there is increased rate of road carnage involving school going children in Nairobi City County especially in public schools; acknowledging the measures the National Transport and Safety Authority (NTSA) has put in place to ensure road safety performance in line with international best practice, this Assembly urges the County Executive to erect or put bumps and signals along County roads that are near schools and other social amenities to save vulnerable schools children from accidents on roads.

## NOTICES

### I. <u>Assembly resolved on Wednesday, February 15, 2017 as follows:</u>

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any Motion, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner:- A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
