NOTICES**I. THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY SPORTS MANAGEMENT BILL, 2017 (ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 9 OF 2017)**

NOTICE is given that the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare, Hon. Wilson Ochola, MCA intends to move the following amendments to the Nairobi City County Sports Management Bill, 2017 at the Committee Stage—

CLAUSE 4

THAT, Clause 4 be amended:

- (i) In sub clause 2 paragraph (e) by deleting the expression **“the County Commissioner”** and substituting therefore the following expression **“a person with disability”**
- (ii) In sub clause 2 paragraph (f) by deleting the expression **“the County Commandant of Police”** and substituting therefore the following **“a representative of the City Inspectorate”**
- (iii) In sub clause 2 paragraph (g) by deleting the whole of paragraph (g) and substituting therefore the following
“At least two youth representatives representing both genders duly appointed by the Governor with approval from the County Assembly”
- (iv) By inserting a new paragraph immediately after paragraph (g)
“A representative from Sports Kenya”

CLAUSE 6

THAT, Clause 6 be amended:

- (i) In sub clause 1 paragraph (c) by inserting the expression **“in collaboration with Sports Kenya”** immediately before the expression **“co-ordinate”**
- (ii) In sub clause 1 paragraph (i) by inserting the expression **“in collaboration with Sports Kenya”** immediately before the expression **“ensure”**
- (iii) In sub clause 1 paragraph (k) by deleting the expression **“other appropriate persons”** appearing immediately before the expression **“with”** substituting therefore the expression **“Sports Kenya”**
- (iv) In sub clause 1 paragraph (n) by inserting the expression **“in collaboration with Sports Kenya”** immediately before the expression **“assist”**
- (v) In sub clause 1 paragraph (q) by inserting the expression **“in collaboration with Sports Kenya”** immediately before the expression **“set”**

II. Assembly resolved on Wednesday, February 15, 2017 as follows:-

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on **Bills NOT sponsored by a Committee**, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party be limited as follows:- A maximum of three hours and thirty minutes, with not more than thirty (30) minutes for the Mover, in moving and ten (10) minutes in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.

III. Assembly resolved on Wednesday, February 15, 2017 as follows:-

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on a **Report of a Committee**, a Sessional Paper or any other Report submitted to the Assembly, be limited as follows: - A maximum of sixty (60) minutes for the Mover in moving and thirty (30) minutes in replying, and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, in that Order.
