The Nairobi City County Government (NCCG) in a bid to improve and expand health facilities within the County has identified two existing hospitals in Pumwani and Mutuini for upgrading and redevelopment.

The County Government intends to undertake this project through an Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC)/ Turnkey Lumpsum Contract.

The following **Response to Statement** was given;-

- i) Response to a Statement by the Chairperson, Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare requested by Hon. Geoffrey Majiwa, MCA, regarding the disciplinary procedures of the County Public Service Board- Executive on employment management
- ii) Response to a Statement by the Chairperson, Sectoral Committee on Planning and Housing requested by Hon. Joseph Wambugu, MCA, regarding the ongoing constructions on riparian land along Karura River in Karura Ward.

5. MOTION - Establishment of an Electric Engineering Directorate under the Energy Sector HON. KENNEDY OBUYA, MCA

AWARE THAT, Paragraph (8)(e) of Part Two of the Forth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides for County Planning and Development, particularly on Electricity and Gas Reticulation and Energy Regulation as a County Function; **FURTHER AWARE** that Section 6 (2) (c) of the County Governments Act, 2012 gives power to the County Governments to delegate any of its functions to its officers, decentralized units or other entities in the County; **NOTING** that Nairobi County is yet to realize its potential on renewable energy from resources such as Solar,

Biogas/Biomass, Wind and by recycling of solid waste; **FURTHER NOTING** that Energy Sub-Sector in the Financial Year 2018/2019 Budgetary allocation had a total budget of Ksh. 360 Million, with an allocation of 340 Million under Development and 20 Million under recurrent to promote use of Clean and Affordable Energy for

Nairobi and its visitors; **CONCERNED** that the Sector lacks sufficient capacity to implement key renewable energy projects such as solar lighting, Biomas technology among others; **APPRECIATING** that there is need for the County Governments to build the existing capacity of the sector to enable them engage on effective Public Private Partnership where necessary as contemplated in Section 6 (3) of the County Governments Act, 2012; this **ASSEMBLY URGES** the County Executive to move with speed and establish a fully-fledged Electrical Engineering Directorate under the existing Energy Sector to enable the County maximize on the existing renewable energy projects in the County for cost effective gains.
