Motion made and Question proposed -

THAT, this Assembly adopts the **REPORT OF THE SELECT** COMMITTEE ON COUNTY FINANCE, BUDGET AND APPROPRIATIONS ON THE CONSIDERATION OF THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY ANNUAL DEVELOPMENT PLAN FY 2021-2021, laid on the Table of the Assembly on Tuesday,2nd March, 2021.

5. MOTION – <u>RENAMING OF A ROAD IN THE CITY AFTER HON. SENATOR</u> <u>YUSUF HAJI.</u>

Motion made and Question proposed -

THAT, aware that the recognition of outstanding citizens who have contributed immensely to the National good is provided for in law, by which the state confers Orders, decorations, and medals; **RECOGNIZING** that in furtherance of this recognition County Governments have equally named roads and other County owned facilities after heroes and heroines, in recognition of their efforts and service to the Nation, which service has contributed to Kenya's prosperity; OBSERVING that the late Hon. Senator Mohamed Yusuf Haji has for fifty-five years served Kenya in various capacities, where he began his public service career as a District Officer in 1960, and rose through the ranks to the position of Provincial Commissioner for several years; **NOTING** that from his public Administration experience, Hon. Haji went on to Serve as Member of Parliament for Ijara Constituency, as Assistant Minister in the Office of the President, and later on Minister of State for Cabinet Affairs in 2002, as Minister of State for Defense, as acting Minister of Internal Security and Provincial Affairs, during which he was notable for his efforts to promote peace and stability in Somalia and beyond, amongst other achievements; **GRATEFUL** that before his demise, the country had further called upon Hon. Haji's exceptional negotiation and strategic mediation skills by entrusting on him the stewardship of the Building Bridges Initiative, which task he took with earnest zeal and delivered a noteworthy Constitutional Amendment Bill whose processing is currently underway; **NOW THEREFORE**, aware that the naming of roads and other public places after heroes and heroines bestows honor and shows our collective gratitude as a nation; this Assembly **RESOLVES** that the Nairobi City County Government in conjunction with the Nairobi Metropolitan Services name or rename a Road in the Central Business District to Senator Mohamed Yusuf Haji in recognition of the late Senator Mohamed Yusuf Haji's immeasurable contribution to the prosperity and well-being of Kenya in his fifty-five years record of public service.
