But we are still in consultation and we will make a conclusive communication over the same so let us wait patiently as we find a lasting solution to the issue because it seems there are a lot of correspondences which actually not we were not previewed to but now we just want to get to understand how it happened. What has come out clear is that the Assembly was never involved and things moved very fast during the period of the campaigns and there were indications of some consultation with the National Government but now we will get to the full details of the issue, and communicate in good time.

7. MOTION - <u>COMPLETION AND PAYMENT OF WARD DEVELOPMENT</u> FUND PROJECTS

THAT, aware that the County Assembly has been appropriating budgets for execution of projects since 2015/2016 financial year including the Wards Development Fund; **concerned** that despite the allocation of funds, the said capital projects have suffered slowed implementation by the County Executive and thus affected the effective delivery of services to Nairobi residents; **noting** that the biggest impediment

to implementation of projects, including Wards Development Fund projects remains endless delays in the procurement process and payment of contractors; **realizing** that there are numerous projects from the preceding financial years that are yet to be completed, while the Assembly has moved ahead to allocate additional monies for FY 2022/2023; **further noting** that several projects have been repetitively factored in the budget in every financial year for the last seven years; **further realizing** that most contractors have lost their investments and properties to the banks due to loans borrowed to fund the County projects; **further concerned** that lack of payments of contractors has contributed to the growing pending bills in the County, this Assembly resolves that the County Executive to prioritize implementation of all pending or incomplete Ward Development Fund projects from FY 2017/18 to FY 2022/2023 including capital projects and ensure payment of completed and certified Ward Development Fund projects and other capital projects across the County.
