4. <u>MOTION - : RECRUITMENT OF THE COUNTY POLICING AUTHORITY</u> <u>PURSUANT TO SECTION 41 OF THE POLICE SERVICE ACT, 2011</u>

Motion made and question proposed;

AWARE THAT, Section 41 of the National Police Service Act, 2011 establishes the County Policing Authority for each county comprising of;

a) the Governor or a member of the County Executive Committee appointed by the Governor, who shall be the chairperson;

b) county representatives appointed by the Inspector-General, who shall comprise the heads of the National Police Service, the National Intelligence Service and the Directorate of Criminal Investigations at the county level;

c) two elected members nominated by the County Assembly; d) the chairperson of the County Security Committee;

e) at least six other members appointed by the Governor, from among the following categories of persons ordinarily resident in the county who shall be recruited through a competitive process by the County Public Service Board, -

- *i) the business sector;*
- *ii) community based organizations;*
- iii) women;
- *iv* persons with special needs;
- iv) religious organizations; and,
- v) the youth.

ACKNOWLEDGING that Section 41 (3) of the same Act requires the aforementioned names once nominated to be vetted by a County Security Committee and subsequent approval by the County Assembly; **APPRECIATING** the functions of the County Policing Authority as stipulated in Section 41(9) being inter-alia; to develop proposals on priorities, objectives and targets for police performance in the county; monitor trends and patterns of crime in the

county including those with a specific impact on women and children; promote community policing initiatives in the county; **DEEPLY CONCERNED** with the high rise of insecurity in the County and Country at large such as broad day muggings, robberies and to some extend murder; NOWTHEREFORE THIS ASSEMBLY urges the County Public Service Board to urgently advertise, recruit and forward the names of the nominees for the County Policing Authority pursuant to Section 41 (1)(e) of the Police Service Act, 2011 for vetting and subsequent approval by the Assembly as a way of augmenting policing initiatives in the County
