4. <u>NOTICE OF MOTION</u> – (HON. KAMAU THUO)

THAT, aware that the Standing Order 15(3) and Standing Order 16(3) were amended by deleting the word 'majority' before the words "removed by" and substituting the words with two thirds thereof; further aware that the amendment put the threshold of removal of the two party leaders too high and that the amendment will not conform with the best practices for the removal of the two leaders, this House resolves that:

- a) Standing Order number 15(3) be amended by deleting the words 'two thirds' before the words "removed by" and substituting with the words "a majority thereof;
- b) Standing Order 16(3) be amended by deleting the words "two thirds" before the words "removed by" and substituting with the words "a majority" thereof.'

Peter Warutere, Member of the County Assembly, regarding property LR Number 110/442 in Roysambu Ward, Garden Estate, which was sold on 15th November, 2013 by the County through the Legal Department in case CMCC number 9.
- Response by Chairperson, Culture and Community Services Committee to Statement sought by Hon. Wilson Ochola, MCA, regarding the manpower capacity of the Nairobi City County Fire Station and its branches.

6. <u>MOTIONS</u> - (<u>TO DETER COMMERCIAL SEX WORKS WITHIN THE</u> <u>CENTRAL BUSINESS DISTRICT</u>)

Motion made and question proposed

THAT, aware that recent years have witnessed a marked increase in the number of commercial sex workers across the streets of Nairobi City Central Business District (CBD); further aware that section 153 and 154 of the penal code prohibits both men and women from living wholly or partly on earnings of prostitution or from soliciting; deeply concerned that the enforcement of that provision of the penal code on prostitution remains lackluster and that commercial sex workers now undertake the unlawful practice openly within the CBD, this Assembly urges the County Government to move with speed and vigorously enforce the provisions of the law to deter the vice within the CBD.
