Hon. Members, as you are all aware, on Wednesday 30th April, 2014, the Assembly passed a resolution for the formation of a Select Committee to Investigate the Conduct of Mr. Evans Ondieki, the CEC Member for Public Works and Transport, pursuant to Standing Order 62 and Section 40(3) of the County Government Act, 2012.

The Committee has concluded its sittings and prepared a report for tabling in the Assembly. Section 40(5a) of the County Government Act, 2012 requires that the Select Committee report back to the Assembly with its verdict within ten days on whether it finds the charges against the CECM sustained or unsubstantiated.

It is for that reason that the request for this, Special sitting was made. Thank you.”
