The Messages regard the nomination of Dr. Bernard Maina Mungenyo as the Chief Officer, Agriculture, Livestock Development and Fisheries, and the nomination of Dr. Bernard N. Muia as a Member of the County Executive Committee responsible for Health Services respectively.

Hon. Members, I now wish to convey the following Messages -

1. NOMINATION OF DR. BERNARD MAINA MUNGENYO AS THE CHIEF OFFICER, AGRICULTURE, LIVESTOCK DEVELOPMENT AND FISHERIES

As you are aware, Article 45(1)(a) of the County Government Act provides that Chief Officer shall be appointed by the Governor with the approval of the County Assembly, from among persons who are competitively sourced and recommended by the Public Service Board.

Pursuant to provisions of Article 45 (1)(a) of the County Government Act, I hereby nominate Dr. Bernard Maina Mungenyo as the Chief Officer, Agriculture, Livestock Development and Fisheries, Nairobi City County.

This is therefore to request the Assembly to approve the said Dr. Bernard Maina Mungenyo as the Chief Officer responsible for Agriculture, Livestock Development and Fisheries, Nairobi City County.

2. NOMINATION OF DR. BERNARD N. MUIA AS A MEMBER OF THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE RESPONSIBLE FOR HEALTH SERVICES

As you are aware, Article 179(2) (b) of the Constitution provides that Members of the County Executive Committee shall be appointed by the county governor, with the approval of the County Assembly, from among persons who are not Members of the Assembly.

Pursuant to provisions of Article 179(2)(b) of the Constitution and Section 35 of the County Government Act, I hereby nominate Dr. Bernard N. Muia as a Member of the Nairobi City County Executive Committee, responsible for Health Services.

This is therefore to request the Assembly to approve the said Dr. Bernard N. Muia as a Member of the Nairobi City County Executive Committee responsible for Health Services.
