VOTES AND PROCEEDINGS

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 23, 2014

1. The House assembled at Forty nine minutes past Two O'clock.
2. The Proceedings were opened with Prayer
3. **NOTICE OF MOTION** – (Hon. Chege Mwaura)

Notice given Pursuant to Section 40 of the County Governments Act, 2012 and Standing Order 62

***THAT**, aware that County Executive Committee Members are state officers bound by Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya 2010 and more so Article 75 (1) (c); **concerned** that the County Executive Committee (CEC) Member for Public Works and Transport Mr. Evans Ondieki recently made allegations in the media imputing improper motives against the Members of the County Assembly (MCAs) thereby casting aspersions against their integrity and standing against Nairobians, and further alleged that the MCAs were compromised and received bribes in order to block the purchase of city buses that had not been budgeted for in the FY 2013/ 14; **noting** that he has gone against the provisions of Section 39 (2) of the County Governments Act 2012, wherein, he has on numerous occasions repeatedly failed to appear before the Sectoral Committee on Transport*

*and Public Works without justifiable reasons and while when he has, has failed to answer questions relating to his responsibilities satisfactorily; **further noting** that on Tuesday, 22nd April, 2014, when he appeared before the said Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works, he was rude and insulted some members of the County Assembly terming them as hooligans. On the said day, he also incited members of public to picket outside the Assembly in order to intimidate the Committee against carrying out its mandate; **aware** that on a previous occasion, the said CEC Member asked elected County Assembly Members to bring lists of proposed 5 roads per ward knowing very well that there were no budgetary provisions for the same and to date nothing tangible has come out of the request thereby causing Assembly Members embarrassment; this Assembly resolves that Pursuant to Section 40 of the County Governments Act and Standing Order 62, this Assembly censures the said CEC member for transport and Public Works and resolves that the Governor do dismiss him from office forthwith on grounds of gross misconduct.*

4. STATEMENT PURSUANT TO STANDING ORDER 41(2)(C)

The following responses to statements were given;

- i. Hon. Wilson Ochola, Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare gave a response to the statement requested by Hon. Magdalene Mbogori regarding lost revenue at the City Stadium as a result of poor facilities, insecurity and lack of adequate staff forcing the County Assembly Football and Netball teams to practice at the Nyayo National Stadium, incurring an additional cost of Ksh. 30,000 per month.

The Speaker requested the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare to come up with an appropriate response regarding the statement requested.

- ii. Hon. Wilson Ochola, Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare gave response to the statement requested

by Hon. Osman Adow Ibrahim regarding the remarks by the Governor that 500 ghost workers were then eradicated from the Nairobi City County Pay roll following a staff audit/headcount.

The Speaker requested the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare to seek an appropriate response regarding the statement requested.

5. **BAN OF MOTORCYCLES AND TUK TUKS FROM ENTERING THE CITY CENTRE**

Motion moved and Question proposed:-

THAT, aware that Nairobi City is getting overpopulated and there is need to have an efficient transport system; deeply concerned that Nairobi City Streets have no special lanes for the motorcycles and many accidents occur on daily basis; further aware that some of these motorcycles are known to use pavements therefore causing unnecessary traffic jam; and that to avoid future disasters since our hospitals are recording a high number of motorcycle victims, there is need to urgently deal with the situation; this Assembly resolves that the County Government bans motorcycles and tuk tuks from entering the City Centre.
