7. MOTION - (Hon. Samuel Kagiri, MCA)

Moved, Question proposed;

THAT, aware that under the Article 186(1) of the Constitution of Kenya, and Fourth Schedule, the functions and powers of County Government, among others, covers County Transport including county roads, street lighting, and public road transport traffic and parking; further aware that the City has designated preferential parking zones and bus termini throughout the City with parking restrictions for each zone; noting that recent years have witnessed a marked increase in the public service vehicles plying various

routes in the County; concerned that most streets, pedestrian walkways and on street parkings in the City Centre have been illegally turned into bus stops and parking slots for public service vehicles, which has led to increased congestion and accidents including deaths to pedestrians, further noting that the allocation of parking, picking and dropping zones for public service vehicles was last done in the year 2000, this Assembly urges the County Executive to abolish all on-street parkings within the Central Business District of the Nairobi City County and direct all the public service vehicles to revert back to the designated bus termini.

Debate arising; Mover replied; Question put and <u>agreed to;</u>

There being no any other business and the time being thirty five minutes past three O'clock, the Temporary Speaker adjourned the Assembly without question put pursuant to Standing Orders.
