The Speaker conveyed the following communication;

“Honorable Members, welcome back from the short recess. It is my sincere hope that you had a wonderful and fruitful break.

Honorable Members, as we commence the last Part of the Fourth Session, the Chair wishes to remind Hon. Members and Chairpersons of pending statements and the need to expedite their conclusion as we near the end of the Fourth Session.

Indeed the Chair has before issued several Communications regarding pending Statements not concluded and directed that Chairpersons conclude with the same expeditiously.

Hon. Members, it is unfortunate that the Assembly still has pending statements from the Second Session of the Assembly. Hon. Members, after Thursday 24th November, 2016, the Chair will not entertain requests for additional information on Statements where the concerned Member did not attend the specific Committee meeting in which officers of the executive were invited to respond to his or her statement in order to obtain as much information as possible from the concerned CECs, Chief Officer or Departments of the Executive.

Hon. Members, Chairpersons and Members with pending requests are advised to strictly observe this directive, so that we have no pending Statements when the Assembly officially adjourns for the long recess as per its Calendar.

The Chair commits to follow up on the forgoing and will report again in a weeks' time.

THAT, aware that solid waste management which is a function of County Government remains a serious challenge to the Nairobi City County Government and residents; concerned that the implementation of waste management faces numerous challenges ranging from inadequate capacity to handle the challenge, corruption within and beyond the County Government, cartels and lethargic nature of County staff and citizenry faced with apathy and collective irresponsibility for waste management; acknowledging the solid waste is an emerging health threat to both levels of government and underscoring its effect on the lives of the people living in Nairobi, the environment and well-being of the city, this Assembly urges the County Government to establish a County Entity or Corporation to be known as Nairobi City County Waste Management Authority with a view to provide leadership and regulate the Sector.
