- **1.** The Assembly assembled at Thirty minutes past Two O'clock.
- **2.** The Proceedings were opened with Prayer.

QUORUM OF THE ASSEMBLY

The Deputy Speaker having confirmed that there was no Quorum caused the Bell to be rung for ten minutes.

There being a Quorum at the expiry of the ten minutes, the Deputy Speaker called the Assembly to order.

3. STATEMENT PURSUANT TO STANDING ORDER 41(2)(C)

Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 41(2) (c), the following responses to statements were issued;

- i.) The Vice-Chairperson of the Select Committee on Finance, Budget & Appropriations gave a response to statement requested by Hon. Rachel Kamweru regarding the alleged plans by the County to hand Laptrust Pension Scheme another Estate in debt swap;
- ii.) The Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works gave a response to statement requested by Hon. Samuel Kagiri regarding the contract to rehabilitate Kimondo Road in Pipeline Ward.

4. <u>MOTION – DRILLING OF PUBLIC BOREHOLES IN ALL THE 85 WARDS TO</u> <u>ENSURE AVAILABILITY OF ADEQUATE, CLEAN AND SAFE WATER FOR</u> <u>THE RESIDENTS OF NAIROBI CITY COUNTY</u>

Motion made:-

THAT, aware that Article 43 (1) (d) of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 states that every person has a right to clean and safe water in adequate quantities; further aware that paragraph 11 (b) of the Part Two of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution stipulates that County Government is to provide County public works and services including water and sanitation services; concerned that most parts of the County especially informal settlements lack clean, safe, sufficient and affordable water, which has led to introduction of untreated water supply businesses within the County; acknowledging that the Nairobi City Water and Sewerage Company has continuously rehabilitated various sources of its water to ensure clean and adequate water supply; noting that the increasing population in the County implies increasing demand for basic amenities such as water supply, this Assembly urges the County Executive to drill public boreholes in all the 85 Wards to ensure availability of adequate, clean and safe water for the residents of Nairobi City County.
