THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY FINANCE ACT, 2022

No. 1 of 2022

Date of Assent: 25th February, 2022

Date of Commencement: See Section 1

AN ACT of the County Assembly of Nairobi City to amend various County legislation relating to taxes, fees and charges for services, and for other revenue raising measures by the County Government; and for matters incidental thereto

ENACTED by the County Assembly of Nairobi City, as follows—

PART I—PRELIMINARY

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Nairobi City County Finance Act, 2022 and shall come into operation 14 days after publication in the *Kenya Gazette*.

Taxes, fees, charges, levies and penalties

2. The taxes, fees, charges, levies and penalties set out in the Charges Column of the schedule shall apply for the respective items listed in the "Items Description" and at the rates set out in the Schedule.

PART II—NAIROBI CITY COUNTY TRANSPORT ACT, 2020

Amendment to the Nairobi City County Transport Act, 2020 Schedules

3. The Nairobi City County Transport Act, 2020 Schedule (sections 29, 47, 51) (is amended as follows—

Schedule (Section 29, 47, 51) amended by inserting "Using of Parking Slots for Offloading only" and their corresponding charges by inserting the new items in their proper sequence and amending the charges for Trailers on street Residential Areas (Not included in CBD and other Areas) and discounting seasonal Tickets (stickers) provided in Nairobi City County Transport Act, 2020 paid through Registered Sacco (Discounts) by 27% for matatus, 34% minibuses, and 28% for buses.

PART IV—NAIROBI CITY COUNTY TRADE LICENSING ACT, 2019

11. The Nairobi City County Trade Licensing Act, 2019 is amended as follows—

Section 15 Amended by deleting it and substituting with new section 15A to read as follows—Renewal of a Licence

- (1) A trade licence is deemed to be renewed when-
- (a) the license fee is paid to the county revenue collector for its renewal on or before the expiry of the licence;
- (b) the holder of the trade licence shall notify the Director of Trade Licencing of any changes in the business including cessation or suspension of business.
- (2) A trade licence r shall be renewed for a period from the date of payment of the license.

Section 26 amended by inserting subsection 26(A) and 26(b) to read as follows—

Section 26(A) (1) any person who-

- (a) carries on business without a valid license;
- (b) carries on a business at any place not specified in a valid trade license or subsidiary license granted to him in respect of such business contravenes section 3;
- (c) fails to display a license as required in section 20(1), any business license granted to him;
- (d) fails to produce a trade license upon being required to do so under section 20(3);
- (e) falsifies any matter relating to an application for the issuance or renewal of a license or causes any matter relating to an application for the issuance or renewal of a license thereof to be falsified;
- (f) alters or forges a license;
- (g) in or in relation to any application for a license makes any statement which is false;
- (h) being a holder of a trade license to which conditions have been annexed under this Act, fails to comply with any sucl condition—

- (i) with intent to evade the payment of the full license fee wilfully does or omits to do any act or thing, shall be liable to pay a penalty of ksh Fifty thousand in addition to the fee payable.
- (2) Failure by a person to pay the penalties and fees provided in sub section (1) may result to the arrest and prosecution of the person.
- (3) A person found guilty under sub section (2) shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty thousand shillings or to a term of imprisonment not exceeding three (3) months or to both such fine and imprisonment.
- (4) Failure to renew respective license at the required time shall attract monthly interest of 3% of the license fees payable.
 - (5) 26B Compounding offences—
- (1) The director of Trade Licensing may, where he is satisfied that a person has committed an offence under this act in respect of which a penalty of a fine provided ,or in respect of which anything is liable to forfeiture, compound the offence and may order that person to pay such sum of money, not exceeding ksh fifty thousand and the Director of Trade licencing of Trade Licensing may order anything liable to forfeiture in connection therewith to be condemned:

Provided that the Director of Trade Licencing shall not exercise his or her powers under this section unless the person admits in writing that he or she has committed the offence and request the Director of Trade licencing to deal with the offence under this section.

- (2) An order by the Director of Trade licencing in accordance with this section shall—
 - (a) be in writing under the hand of Director of Trade Licencing and the offender, and witnessed by an officer;
 - (b) specify the name of the offender, the offence committed, the sum of money ordered by the Director of Trade Licencing to be paid, and the date or dates on which payment is to be made;
 - (c) have a copy of the written admission referred to under subsection(2) attached;
 - (d) be served on the offender;
 - (e) be final and not be subject to appeal; and
 - (f) on production in any court, be treated as proof of the conviction of the offender for the offence specified, and may be enforced in

the same manner as a decree of a court for the payment of amount stated therein.

- (3) If the director of Trade Licencing compounds an offence under this section, the offender shall not be liable for prosecution or penalty in respect of the same act or omission, the subject of the compounded offence except with the express consent of the Director of Public prosecutions.

- 17. The Nairobi City County Revenue Administration Act, 2019 is amended by inserting the following sub sections (c) and (d) immediately after sub section 41 (b);
- (c) Notwithstanding any provision of this Act, an officer who before the commencement of this Act was responsible for revenue collection and enforcement may exercise the powers under this Act pending the appointment of the Board of Directors and the staff of the Board under sections 6,8,12 and 13 of the Act";
- (d) Unless the Board otherwise determines, all persons being officers appointed by the County Public Service Board, who before the commencement of this Act are employed by the County for purposes of revenue collection and designated as revenue officers by the County Executive, shall on the commencement of this Act, be deemed to be or secondment to the Authority until they are employed in the service of the Authority in accordance with this Act or the secondment with the Authority otherwise ceases in accordance with the terms of the secondment.

PART X—THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY ALCOHOLIC DRINKS CONTROL AND LICENSING ACT, 2014

- 18. The Nairobi City County Alcoholic Drinks Control and Licensing Act, 2014 is hereby amended as follows—
 - (a) in Section 2 by inserting the following new definitions in prope alphabetical order;

"Fees" means amount paid for a service to cater for the cos incurred in the provision of such a service;

"Penalties/Interest" means an amount charged above the principal outstanding or late payment beyond stipulated period;

- (a) by inserting a new Part VIII headed "Fees and Charges" immediately after Part VII;
- (b) by inserting a new section under Part VIII as follows-

- (c) "the fees, charges and penalties in this act shall be as contained in the Fourth Schedule";
- (d) by inserting thereof, the Schedule in Part 11 of the Nairobi City County Revenue Act, 2015 titled "Liquor Licenses" as the Fourth Schedule and naming it "Fees and Charges";
- (e) that the Fourth Schedule of the Act be amended by inserting and revising the charges with respect to the following items—
