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## **THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY FINANCE BILL, 2025**

### **A Bill for**

**AN ACT of the County Assembly of Nairobi City to amend various County legislations relating to taxes, fees and charges for services, and for other revenue raising measures by the County Government; and for connected purposes**

**ENACTED** by Nairobi City County Assembly, as follows—

### **PART I—PRELIMINARY**

#### **Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the Nairobi City County Finance Act, 2025 and shall come into operation 14 days after publication in the *Kenya Gazette*.

#### **Tariffs and Pricing Policy**

2. This Act is anchored on the Nairobi City County Tariffs and Pricing Policy, 2025.

#### **Taxes, Fees, Charges, Levies and Penalties**

3. The taxes, fees, charges, levies and penalties set out in the Charges Column of the schedules shall apply for the respective items listed in the “Items Description” and at the rates set out in the Schedule.

### **PART II — NAIROBI CITY COUNTY REVENUE ACT, 2015**

#### **Amendment of the Nairobi City County Revenue Act, 2015**

4. (1) The Nairobi City County Revenue Act, 2015 is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after the Short title —

##### **2A “Objectives and Purpose of the Act”**

(1) The object and purpose of this Act is to—

- (a) provide a legal framework for the imposition, variation, administration, and collection of fees, charges, and levies for services rendered by the Nairobi City County Government and its agencies;
- (b) consolidate into one law the provisions relating to such fees, charges, and levies to ensure uniformity and clarity;
- (c) promote efficiency, certainty, and transparency in the administration of county revenues derived from services;
- (d) safeguard the revenue-raising capacity of the County in

line with Articles 209(4), 210, and 174 of the Constitution;

- (e) safeguard the revenue-raising capacity of the County in line with Articles 209(4), 210, and 174 of the Constitution;
- (f) ensure equity, accountability, and public participation in the design and administration of county fees and charges; and
- (g) provide mechanisms to prevent revenue leakages and enhance compliance.

(2) The Nairobi City County Revenue Act, 2015 is amended by deleting Schedule 3.6 titled “Transport of quarry materials in and out of Nairobi”.

(3) The Nairobi City County Revenue Act, 2015 is amended by deleting Schedule 6.0 titled “Public Works and Infrastructure”.

(4) The Nairobi City County Revenue Act, 2015 is amended by deleting Schedule 6.5 titled “Road Engineering Services”

(5) Schedule 9.2 of the Nairobi City County Revenue Act, 2015 titled “Rental Markets – Monthly rent per stall” is amended by (a) deleting the corresponding charges and substituting therefor with the following new charges—

### **PART III — NAIROBI CITY COUNTY TRANSPORT ACT, 2020**

21. Section 2 of the Nairobi City County Transport Act, 2020, is amended by inserting the following new definitions in proper alphabetical sequence —

“County Transport Facilities” means bus stops on county roads, laybys, county roads, county bus terminus and other facilities funded by the County for transport purposes

“Nairobi Metropolitan Transport Authority” means the Authority established under the Nairobi Metropolitan Transport Authority Act”;

“Non-motorized transport” means human-powered transportation methods like walking, cycling, and using handcarts or wheelchairs providing basic mobility without a motor to propel it”;

“Public Transport Facilities” means public or private property, structures, improvements, buildings, personnel, equipment, plant, vehicle parking or other facilities, rights-of-way, or any combination thereof used or useful for the purposes of transporting passengers by means of a street, railway, motor vehicle, motor bus, or any bus or other means of conveyance operating as a common carrier by the public and authorized and licensed by national government agencies and counties.

“Road furniture” means fixtures on a road designed to provide safety and information, including traffic lights, signposts, guardrails, fences,

marker posts, reflectors, center-line pads, road markings and traffic islands.

22. Section 42 of the Nairobi City County Transport Act, 2020, is amended by inserting the following new sub-sections after sub-section (4)—

(5) The County shall levy a charge on exemption permits for movement of abnormal or oversize loads.

(6) The County may collaborate with stakeholders, other county and national government agencies to conduct motor vehicle inspections and impose a fee, levy or charge.

(7) Any person who overloads a motorcycle, vehicle, truck or trailer is liable upon conviction to a fine as prescribed under Schedule 2 of this Act and imprisonment of a term not exceeding six months or to such fine and imprisonment as imposed.”

23. The Nairobi City County Transport is amended by inserting the following new part immediately after Part VIII titled “Road Restoration Levy”

#### **PART VIIIA— ROAD RESTORATION LEVY**

##### **Imposition of levy**

65A. (1) There shall be paid a levy to be known as a Road Restoration Levy on all vehicles transporting construction or related materials within Nairobi City County.

(2) The Levy shall be charged for purposes of maintaining and restoring county roads damaged or adversely affected by such transportation.

##### **Rate of Levy**

65B. (1) The Levy shall be payable at such rates as may be prescribed in the Schedule to this Act or as may be determined from time to time.

(2) Different rates may be applied based on—

- (a) the tonnage or weight of the vehicle;
- (b) the nature of the materials being transported; and
- (c) the route or class of road used.

##### **Collection and Administration**

65C. (1) The County Executive Committee Member responsible for transport, in consultation with the County Executive Committee

Member responsible for finance, shall designate collection points and enforcement mechanisms for the Levy.

(2) The Levy shall be collected by authorized county officers or agents duly appointed under this Act.

#### **Use of Levy**

65D. (1) All proceeds from the Road Restoration Levy shall be paid into the County Revenue Fund.

(2) Monies so collected shall be earmarked for road maintenance, rehabilitation, and restoration works within the County.

24. Section 67 of the Nairobi City County Transport Act is amended—

(a) by inserting the following new section after Section 67

“67A (1) Upon the approval by the County Assembly, the County Executive Committee member responsible for county treasury may impose fees and charges for the better carrying out of the objects and purposes of this Act.

(2) Fees and Charges imposed under this Act shall be contained in the schedules in this Act.”

(b) by inserting the following new section after Section 67A

“67B. Any person who vandalizes county road furniture is guilty of an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine as prescribed under Second Schedule of this Act, or imprisonment of a term not exceeding 3 years, or both.

(c) by inserting the following new section after Section 67 B

“67C. Any person who damages clamps affixed on vehicles by authorized officers is guilty of an offence and is liable upon conviction to a fine as prescribed under Second Schedule of this Act.”

**PART XIII— NAIROBI CITY COUNTY REVENUE  
ADMINISTRATION ACT, 2021**

42. The Nairobi City County Revenue Administration Act, 2021, is amended by deleting Section 6 and substituting therefor with the following new Section—

(6) a. There is established a Board of Directors which shall be the governing body of the Authority.



b. The Board shall comprise the following members —

- (i) a non-executive chairperson to be appointed by the Governor with the approval of the County Assembly;
- (ii) the Chief Officer for the time being responsible for Finance;
- (iii) the Chief Officer for the time being responsible for Revenue;
- (iv) five other persons appointed by the Executive Committee Member with a minimum degree from a recognized university in Kenya and relevant knowledge and experience in accountancy, commerce, law, taxation, business administration or public administration; (include qualifications of these members).
- (v) the County Revenue Administrator (as desired by the County) who shall be an *ex-officio* member.

43. Section 31 of The Nairobi City County Revenue Administration Act, 2021, is amended by deleting paragraph (a) and substituting therefor the following new paragraph —

(a) “monies not less than two per centum of the revenue estimated in the financial estimates for each financial year to be collected by the Board under this Act as may be determined by the Executive Committee Member in each financial year.”

44. Section 41 is amended by deleting the words “coming into force of this Act” appearing in sub-section (1) and substituting therefor the words “the constitution of the Board under section 6”

45. The Nairobi City County Revenue Administration Act, 2021, is amended by inserting a new section immediately after section 11 to read as follows:—

#### **11A. Whistle blower reward**

(1) The Executive Committee Member may, upon the recommendation of the County Revenue Administrator reward any person for information leading to the identification or recovery of unpaid revenue: Provided that this section shall not apply to any staff of the County Assembly Service Board, County Public Service Board or the Authority or any other corporation of the Nairobi City County Government:

Provided that this section shall not apply to any staff of the County Assembly Service Board, County Public Service Board or the Authority or any other corporation of the Nairobi City County Government.

(2) The reward payable under sub-section (1) shall be with respect to payment of a penalty prescribed by any revenue law and shall be fifty per centum of the penalty paid or Kenya Shillings. One hundred thousand, whichever is the lesser.

(3) The Executive Committee Member shall prescribe guidelines for implementation of the whistle blower policy under this section.

49. The Nairobi City County Revenue Administration Act, 2021, is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 38 —

### **38A Compounding of Offences**

1. The County Revenue Administrator may, where he is satisfied that a person has committed an offence under a revenue law, compound the offence and may order that person to pay such sum of money, not exceeding the amount of the fine to which he or she would have been liable if he or she had been prosecuted and convicted for the offence, as the County Revenue Administrator may think fit and the County Revenue Administrator may order anything liable to forfeiture in connection therewith to be condemned:

Provided that the County Revenue Administrator shall not exercise his or her powers under this section unless the person admits in writing that he or she has committed the offence and requests for the offence to be dealt with in accordance with this section.

2. For the purposes of sub-section (2), the County Revenue Administrator shall constitute a committee of not less than three officers to consider applications for compounding of offences.

3. An order by the County Revenue Administrator in accordance with this section shall—

- (i) be in writing and executed by an authorized officer, the offender, and witnessed officer;
- (ii) specify the name of the offender, the offence committed, the sum of money ordered by the County Revenue Administrator to be paid, and the date or dates on which payment is to be made;
- (iii) have a copy of the written admission referred to under sub-section (2) attached;
- (iv) be served on the offender; and
- (v) on production in any court, be treated as proof of the conviction of the offender for the offence specified and may be enforced in the same manner as a decree of a court for the payment of the amount stated therein.

4. If the County Revenue Administrator compounds an offence under this section, the offender shall not be liable for prosecution or penalty in respect of same act or omission,

the subject of the compounded offence except where authorized by the Director of Public Prosecutions.

50. The Nairobi City County Revenue Administration Act, 2021, is amended by inserting the following new section immediately after section 39 to read as follows—

**39A Notice to appear before the County Revenue Administrator**

Where the County Revenue Administrator is satisfied that a person has committed an offence under a revenue law, the County Revenue Administrator may, by notice in writing, require the person to appear before him.
