**LAYING OF GAZETTE NOTICES FOR DECLARATION
OF MEMBERS ELECTED TO THE COUNTY ASSEMBLY**

Hon. Members, Standing Order 4(2)(a) provides that on the first sitting of a new County Assembly after a general election, the Clerk shall read the notification of the convening of the County Assembly as published in the Kenya Gazette and the County Gazette.

Hon. Members, this has since been done.

Further, Standing Order 4(2)(b) provides that on the first sitting of a new County Assembly after a general election, *the Clerk shall lay a list of the names of the persons elected as Members on the Table of the County Assembly.*

Hon. Members, by elected, it is meant members elected from the 85 Wards in Nairobi City County, and the equivalent number of nominated Members of County Assembly pursuant to Article 177(1)(b) and (c) of the Constitution. I confirm that I have prepared the list

containing the names of all persons elected as I have explained as Members of the County Assembly.


Hon. Members, the elected Members of the Nairobi City County Assembly were formally declared vide Gazette Notice No. 8240 and Gazette Notice No. 8380.
