## GENERAL CONDUCT OF HONOURABLE MEMBERS

---

### Honorable Members

1. Further to my earlier communication on the conduct of Hon. Members within the Assembly precincts, I have noted with great concern the un-becoming conduct by Hon. Members towards each other or the House Leadership. In particular, I have noted the increased hurling of abuses and use of unparliamentarily language among Hon. Members and towards the House Leadership while in plenary, committee rooms, offices and other Assembly activities. This is a vice that the Chair condemns in the strongest terms possible.
2. The Chair wishes to remind the House that as State Officers, our conduct is governed by the objects and principles of good governance as contained in the Constitution, the Leadership and Integrity Act, 2011 and the Leadership and Integrity Code for State Officers.
3. Further, Standing Order 116 on gross disorderly conduct prohibits the use of unparliamentarily language by Hon. Members under whatever circumstances. The very Standing Order provides for the sanctions that can be taken against a Hon. Member whose conduct is gross disorderly.
4. In this regard, Hon. Members, the Chair advises all Hon. Members to avoid this unbecoming conduct and uphold the highest standards of respect towards each other. However, should such behavior persist, the Chair will have no option but to sanction such Members.

The House is so guided.
