1.0 PREFACE

Mr. Speaker Sir, on behalf of the Members of the Sectoral Committee on Transport, Roads and Public Works it is my pleasure and privilege to present to the Assembly, the Committee's 2016 1st Report on roads inspection site visit to Nyayo Highrise Ward on Thursday 3rd March 2016.

2.0 BACKGROUND

Nyayo Highrise ward is an electoral ward in Nairobi City County. It is one of the wards in Langata constituency in Nairobi County. It encompasses an area of approximately 0.4km square. Nyayo Highrise is next to Kibera Blessed Academy and is located not far from Nairobi Central Business District. Nyayo Highrise has a length of 5.3 kilometers.

The Transport, Roads and Public Works Committee during its meeting held on 25th February 2016 resolved to visit the Nyayo Highrise Ward to look at the state of roads and drainages in the Estate/Ward following complaints from the County Ward Representative of the poor state of the roads. The visit thus took place on Thursday 3rd March 2016.

2.1 Committee Mandate

Mr. Speaker Sir, the Sectoral Committee on Transport, Roads and Public Works is established under Standing Order 191, and its mandate amongst others, as outlined under Standing Order 191 (5) is to:-

- a) investigate, inquire into, and report on all matters relating to the mandate, management, activities, administration, operations and estimates of the assigned departments;
- study the programme and policy objectives of departments and the effectiveness of the implementation;
- study and review all county legislation referred to it;

- d) study, assess and analyze the relative success of the departments as measured by the results obtained as compared with its stated objectives;
- e) investigate and inquire into all matters relating to the assigned departments as they may deem necessary, and as may be referred to them by the County Assembly;
- f) vet and report on all appointments where the Constitution or any law requires the County Assembly to approve, except those under Standing Order 185(Committee on Appointments): and
- g) Make reports and recommendations to the County Assembly as often as possible, including recommendation of proposed legislation.

3.0 INSPECTION OF NYAYO HIGHRISE ROADS AND DRAINAGES

The Committee was received by the Highrise Ward County Assembly Representative, Hon. Maurice Akuk. The delegation proceeded to inspect the road leading into the Nyayo Highrise Estate Ward and thereafter other roads within the Ward.

The observations and challenges noted by the Committee are highlighted in this report.


4.0 OBSERVATIONS MADE BY THE COMMITTEE

- -The 1km stretch tarmac road entering into Highrise estate was filled with little potholes, however KURA had done some repatching of the potholes.
- -At the Kibera access road, the Committee noticed culverts which were blocked with soil and garbage and needed desilting. This blockage has caused rain water to wear out the tarmac since it remained stagnant on the road due to inability to flow as a result of clogged drainages.
- -A tender for the construction of a motorable bridge along the Kibera access road had been awarded to a contractor as per information from the area Ward Representative but no works had commenced on it yet despite the urgent need. The Committee also saw an open trench where a Member of the public lost his life after slipping and falling into it.
- -At Kibwezi road, the Committee noted that despite Ksh 326m having been allocated for the rehabilitation of the 0.95km road by the Ministry of Housing (according to the Ward Rep), no works have ever commenced on the ground. Traders who had been cleared from the roadside seemed to be slowly making a comeback. The road needs a grader and a drainage system for rain water. It was also noted that the National Youth Service had started rehabilitating the road but abandoned it later.

5.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

Mr. Speaker following the visit, the Committee urges this Assembly to resolve as follows;

- That desilting to remove soil and garbage be done on all clogged culverts to improve drainage systems along the Kibera access road and any other roads within Nyayo Highrise Ward;
- Construction of the motorable bridge along the Kibera access road be fast tracked to ease traffic flow and enhance safety of pedestrians crossing the waterway; and
- Construction on Kibwezi road be commenced. Traders to be cleared from the roadside to allow for the smooth construction of the road. A proper drainage system for easy flow of rain water be constructed.




