2.0 BACKGROUND

2.1 ESTABLISHMENT OF THE SECTORAL COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORT AND PUBLIC WORKS


The Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works is one of the Sectoral Committees established under Standing Order No. 191(5) with the mandate to consider for approval by the Assembly, appointment of Chief Officer under Section 45(1)(b) of the County Government Act. The said Section requires H.E. the Governor to nominate and with the approval of the County Assembly, appoint County Chief Officers.

2.2 APPOINTMENT PROCESS OF THE COUNTY CHIEF OFFICER NOMINEE

- (i) Pursuant to Section 45(1)(a) of the County Government Act, H.E. the Governor, forwarded to the Speaker of the Nairobi City County Assembly, the name of the one (1) nominee vide a letter dated 25th September, 2013 for vetting by the Committee on Transport and Public Works and consideration for approval by the Nairobi City County Assembly for appointment as County Chief Officer.
- (ii) On Tuesday 1st October, 2013, the Honourable Speaker in a communication to the Assembly, informed the Assembly that the Clerk of the Nairobi City County had received the names of the said one (1) nominee and directed that the names and Curriculum Vitae of the said nominees be referred to the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works for vetting and reporting to the House within 14 days.
- (iii) The public was expected to participate in the vetting process through submission of memoranda (affidavit) on the suitability or otherwise of the nominees. On Tuesday October 8th, 2013, the Clerk of the Nairobi City County Assembly placed an advertisement in the print media inviting the public to submit memoranda by 14th October, 2013 on the suitability or otherwise of the said one (1) nominee. As a result, no memoranda was received from the public.

3.0 VETTING OF THE COUNTY CHIEF OFFICER NOMINEE

In conducting the vetting process, the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works examined the nominees against the following criteria, amongst others.

- (ii) Employment record
- (iii) Professional affiliations

- (iv) Potential conflict of interest
- (v) Knowledge of the relevant subject
- (vi) Overall suitability for the position
- (vii) Tax compliance
- (viii) Integrity

During its Sittings held on Monday 15th October, 2013, at the Council Chambers (City Hall Buildings), the Committee orally vetted the nominee for appointment as County Chief Officer. The Minutes of the vetting proceedings are attached. *(Annex 2).*

3.1 MRS. CHRISTINE ADONGO OGUT – COUNTY CHIEF OFFICER NOMINEE FOR TRANSPORT, ROADS AND PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

i) Academic Qualifications

- She is a holder of master of Science Degree in Urban Infrastructure Engineering and Management – UNESCO – IHE, Delft, Netherlands

- Diploma in Environment and Public Transport Management at Vogocho Transportforsknings Institute (UTI), Linkoping Sweden.
- B.S.C(Civil Engineering), Upper Second Class Honors – University of Nairobi.

ii) **Employment Record**

- She is currently working with Kenya Urban Roads Authority as a manager (planning), where she coordinates the preparation of the Budget and Performance Contracting
- Served as a member of National Urban Transport Improvement Project funded by World Bank.
- Served as a chairperson at Kenya Urban Roads Authority in the Development Committee on gender balance.
- Served as Deputy City Engineer / Director of Environment at the City Council of Nairobi during which she introduced the collection of garbage 24/7 and monthly clean up in all the constituencies.
- Served as the Project Engineer in the City Council of Nairobi for the rehabilitation of enterprise/ Lusaka roads.
- Served as a resource person at the City Council of Nairobi on strategic planning and Rapid Result Initiative for Kenya Municipal Project under discussion with the World Bank.

(iii) **Professional Affiliation**

- She informed the meeting that she was a registered Engineer, Associate Member for Charter Institute for Engineers,
- Corporate Member of the Institution of Engineers of Kenya, Chairperson of Advocacy and Publicity Committee of Institution of Engineers of Kenya,
- Member of the Training and Conference Committee of IEK,
- Associate Member of the Institute of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators.
- Ex-Board member, Public Procurement Administrative Review Board and Member of Board of Governors, BuruBuru Girls Secondary School.

iii) Overall suitability for the position

She informed the committee that she is the most suitable person for the job and that her track record speaks for itself. She is capable to motivate workers to achieve their target. She will use the technology to receive all collections on parking charges.

On roads maintenance she will utilize the resources available to improve and maintain roads in the estates. She will give staff job security and work with the new officers. She will improve on picking and dropping points of passengers for public service vehicles. Footbridges should be made secure for public use. She further stated that she will take inventory for the youth and what they do in order to create 20,000 new temporary jobs for the youths within the County.

iv) Potential Conflict of Interest

She stated that he has no potential conflict of interest.

v) Knowledge of the relevant job

- She also indicated that she had worked for the Nairobi City Council as Deputy City Engineer / Director of Environment and introduced the collection of garbage 24/7 and monthly clean up in all the constituencies.
- Mr. John Gakuo's tenure as the Town Clerk, she played a key role in road markings, street lighting, strategic plan and leader for Rapids Result Initiative for Kenya Municipal Project under discussion with the World Bank. She also initiated collection of ksh. 11.2 million at Wakulima Market.
- At her own time, she talks to girls about Engineering. She sits in Engineering Women Charter. When she was in the council, she assisted 10 No. Engineers to be registered.
- During her tenure in the Council, there was a patrol team which went round checking the roads. There was also a hotline to report. Completion of projects depended on availability of resources. She tabled a document on supervision checklist which she stated that on monthly basis would assist in monitoring what the contractor was

doing. There was also procurement checklist to monitor and hoped the City County would embrace the method.

- She would also put in practice things that she learned in Netherlands. She also stated that if she gets the job, she would work hard to make Nairobi the county of choice. She was also a law abiding citizen who just wanted to work for this county.
- She ressonated that the chief officer was the accounting officer who runs day to day activities. A technical officer who was always on time to offer a hearing ear to the public to avoid complaints. She further stated that she had a wealth of experience as she was employed in 1990 as a graduate engineer.

vi) **Tax Compliance**

The nominee stated to the Committee that he has fully complied with his tax obligation.

vii) **Integrity**

On integrity she responded that integrity was about doing the right thing and being honest. She stated that she was an honest person and puts the interest of people first. She quoted the verse in the Bible that states that the truth will set you free. To the best of her knowledge, she was honest. The nominee has never been charged in a Court of Law.

i) **Conflict of Interest**

She stated that in her application form, she had disclosed that she is married to a member of Nairobi City County Assembly. She also added that her marriage will not influence her performance and in case of any conflict of interest, she would resign.

The meeting was called to order at 10.30 a.m and the opening prayer was read by Mr. Evans Mogire, Clerk Assistant

The Chairperson welcomed all members of the committee to the meeting. She informed the members that the meeting had been called upon to vet the nominee for the post of the Chief Officer, Public Works, Roads and Transport Department.

Eng. Christine Adongo Ogut appeared before the committee on Transport and Public Works and the Chairperson welcomed her for the vetting exercise and also requested members to introduce themselves. The Chairperson also requested the officer to introduce herself.

A member requested her to inform the committee about herself on the following:

- ii. Employment record
- iii. Professional affiliation
- iv. Relevant experience

Professional Affiliation

She informed the meeting that she was a registered Engineer, Associate Member for Charter Institute for Engineers, Corporate Member of the Institution of Engineers of Kenya, Chairperson of Advocacy and Publicity Committee of Institution of Engineers of Kenya, Member of the Training and Conference Committee of IEK, Associate Member of the Institute of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. She also reported that she was a previous board member, Public Procurement Administrative Review Board and Member of Board of Governors, BuruBuru Girls Secondary School.

A member asked her to state what makes her think that she was the most suitable person for the job and she responded that track record speaks for herself. She was able to motivate workers to achieve the target. Would use the technology to receive all collections on parking. On roads maintenance she would utilize the resources available to maintain and improve on roads in the estates. Would give staff job security and work with the new officers. She would improve on picking and dropping points of passengers for public service vehicles. Footbridges should be made secure for public use. She further stated that Hon. Members would like to know how many jobs she would create in 100 days and she indicated that she would take inventory for the youth and what they do. She also stated that since she did not know the counties target, in 100 days she would create 20,000 temporary jobs for the youth.

A member enquired what was the role of the Chief Officer in the Department.

She responded that the chief officer was the accounting officer who runs day to day activities. A technical officer who was always on time to offer a hearing ear to the public to avoid complaints. She further stated that she had a wealth of experience as she was employed in 1990 as a graduate engineer.

A member enquired since she had been an engineer at City Hall before, was she tax compliant. She responded that she had a tax compliance certificate.

On integrity she responded that integrity was about doing the right thing and being honest. She stated that she was an honest person and puts the interest of people first. She quoted the verse in the Bible that states that the truth will set you free. To the best of her knowledge, she was honest.

A member asked her whether she had any case pending in court or whether she had ever been sued by anybody. She responded that there was no case in court but what she had was a certificate of good conduct. She had never been accused by police and she had a good track record.

A member commended the officer for her good C.V. He stated that Kura was hesitant to use Councils resources. The City County of Nairobi had the capacity to maintain their own roads. She was asked whether she was willing to take over City County functions fully and maintain the county roads. She was also asked whether she was willing to give the county the best. She responded that the City County had 7No. Registered engineers and others not registered. She enquired whether the staff was motivated.

What was being done to hold engineers accountable for any shoddy work done. She indicated that there was 1, 600 kilometers of road not done by KURA and therefore with the goodwill from the Hon. Members and Executive, roads in the city and the estates would be maintained.

A member sought to know how she was going to relate with members and officers of the county assembly and whether she would have a good working relationship with this committee. She responded that the relationship would be based on open door policy to indicate what was possible and what was not possible and also to seek advice on how it could be possible. Concerning giving the first priority to members, she stated that she would not pick their calls only when she was in a meeting otherwise there was no reason why she should not pick calls. Her office would be opened to all.

A member indicated that any document prepared had its own specifications on how the work should be done. What was her intention when the contractor does not do as required and she responded that the cost would be to the contractor.

A member asked how she was going to deal with people who use council as cash cow, would they continue eating or how would she reduce the cartels. She responded that check lists would be introduced and be circulated to staff and they would be trained on how to use them and check the quality and specifications. ~~Check what the officers were doing on~~ the ground. Stakeholders should be visiting city county projects and own the projects. She further stated that it was about systems and everything would be reported to this committee. Members of the public should also report shoddy work done by the contractors to this committee. She urged the members to own the projects in their own wards and to work together as a team.

A member requested her to state the mandate of Transport and Public Works Committee and she responded that the mandate was to ensure that the public transport system was streamlined, and the vision was to ensure public transport system was reliable and safe.

A member noted that her C.V was very impressive. He enquired what her salary expectations were. She responded that she hoped the salary would be negotiable. She also stated that at the end of the day it was not about money but about job satisfaction and how to relate with other people.

In her conclusion, she stated that when one seeks for a job, it could go either way. She indicated that she had answered questions to the best of

her knowledge and hoped she had satisfied the panel. She wished all the members well.
