On Tuesday, 10th April, 2018, the Honourable Speaker in a Message to the Assembly informed the Assembly that the Assembly had received the name of Ms. Lydia Kwamboka, and directed that the name and curriculum vitae of the said nominee be referred to the Select Committee on Appointments for vetting and reporting to the Assembly pursuant to Standing Order 196, provisions of the Nairobi City County Office of the County Attorney Act, 2016 and Section 10 (1) of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act. No. 5 of 2017.

2.3 Notification to the Public

Section 7(4) and (5) of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, 2017 provides that-, "7(4) any person may, prior to the approval hearing and by a written statement on oath, provide the Clerk with evidence contesting the suitability of a candidate to hold the office to which the candidate has been nominated" and "7(5) the committee shall, by notice in at least one newspaper of national circulation, notify the public of the time and place for holding an approval hearing at least seven days prior to the hearing".

Pursuant to the above provisions of the law, the Clerk of the County Assembly placed an advertisement in the in the local dailies, specifically the Standard Newspaper and the Nation Newspaper on Wednesday 11th April, 2018 inviting the public to submit memoranda by way of written statements on oath (*sworn affidavits*) on the suitability or otherwise of the nominee.

At the close of business on Monday 16thApril, 2018, no memoranda contesting the suitability of the nominee had been received from the public.

In accordance with the provisions of Article 118 of the Constitution and Section 7(4) of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, 2017 the general public was also notified in the local dailies by the Clerk of the County Assembly of the intention of the Select Committee on Appointments to conduct the vetting and approval hearing of the nominee on Thursday 19th April, 2018.

2.4 Clearance Requirements

To ensure compliance with the provisions of Chapter 6 of the Constitution, the nominee was asked to submit her clearance status with the following institutions for the vetting exercise –

- a) Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA)
- b) Criminal Investigation Department (CID)
- c) Higher Education Loans Board (HELB)
- d) Credit Reference Bureau (CRB) and
- e) The Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC)

The clearance by the foregoing institutions was primarily meant to provide information about the nominee on: -

- a) Matters touching on integrity;
- b) Tax compliance;

- c) Loan repayments; and
- d) Presence or absence of criminal records.

3.0 VETTING OF NOMINEE FOR OFFICE OF COUNTY ATTORNEY

In conducting the vetting process, the Select Committee on Appointments examined the nominee against the following criteria, amongst others, as set out in the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act No. 5 of 2017—

- (i.) Academic qualifications.
- (ii.) Employment record;
- (iii.) Professional associations;
- (iv.) Potential conflict of interest;
- (v.)Knowledge of the relevant subject;
- (vi.) Overall suitability for the position;
- (vii.) Tax compliance; and
- (viii.) Integrity.

The nominee was similarly examined against the provisions of Section 5 of the Nairobi City County Office of the County Attorney Act, 2016, on the qualifications for appointment to the office of County Attorney.

During its Sitting held on Thursday 19th April, 2018 at Charter Hall, Assembly Precincts, City Hall Buildings from 12:00pm, the Committee conducted a face to face interview of the nomince. The minutes of the vetting proceedings are attached to this report.

3.1. <u>APPEARANCE BEFORE THE COMMITTEE BY MS. LYDIA KWAMBOKA – NOMINEE FOR COUNTY ATTORNEY</u>

The nominee appeared before the Committee on Thursday 19th April, 2018 at 12.00pm and after introductions, she was informed by the Chairperson that in line with the provisions of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act No. 5 of 2017, the Committee invited Memoranda from the Public on her suitability or otherwise for appointment to public office, but none was received.

While under oath, she proceeded to inform the Committee as follows:-

- A. Regarding self-introduction, knowledge, experience and qualification, the nominee informed the committee as follows, that:-
 - (i.) She was born on 4th October, 1969.
 - (ii.) She is currently a practicing advocate with L. Kwamboka & Co. Advocates.
 - (iii.) She is also currently undertaking a Masters Degree in Diplomacy, Development and International Security at Daystar University.
 - (iv.) She holds a Bachelor of Laws Degree from the Dr. B.A Marathwada University, India.
 - (v.) She also holds a Bachelors of Social Legislation Degree from the Dr. B.A Marathwada University, India.
 - (vi.) She similarly holds a Post-graduate Diploma in Law from the Kenya School of Law.
 - (vii.) She's a member of the following professional associations;
 - The Law Society of Kenya (LSK);
 - Pro bono Lawyer with Coalition of Violence Against Women (COVAW); and
 - > Federation of Women Lawyers (FIDA) Kenya.
 - (viii.) The nominee previously worked as a Chief Legal Officer with BlueShield Insurance from 2003 to 2004; Chief Legal Officer with the United Insurance Company Limited from 2001 to 2003; Legal Officer with City Radiators Limited from 1999 to 2001and Legal Officer with Credit Reference Bureau (K) Limited from 1997 to 1998.
- B. In response to questions put to her by Members of the Committee, Ms. Lydia Kwamboka responded as follows:-
 - I. As to her Qualifications and Suitability for the position nominated The nominee observed as follows, that
 - a) The experience and training she has accumulated over the years equips her with

the necessary skills to serve in the Office of the County Attorney.

- b) She has served as Chief Legal Officer for major companies, which experience is requisite to the position nominated.
- c) Overall, his educational qualifications, vast past experience and technical knowledge as demonstrated will suffice in position nominated.

II. Regarding why she applied for the position nominated -

The nominee informed the committee as follows, that -

a) Her training as a Lawyer and involvement in top leadership at various levels related to the Legal services sector, as well as her passion for justice provided her biggest motivation for applying for the position nominated.

III. With Respect to how she will Deal With Challenges Bedeviling The Legal Services Department, Especially Garnishee Orders-

The nominee informed the committee as follows, that -

- a) The question of garnishee orders against government, whether National or county, was contrary to the law and an unfortunate situation.
- b) It is a major challenge to the Legal Services Department which she plans to tackle.
- c) Regretted that some officers of the County Government Legal Services Department were colluding with fraudsters to fleece the County through exorbitant legal fees.
- d) She will work to build capacity of the department to ensure the county can handle its own litigation.

IV. Regarding debts to lawyers and how she plans to deal with the bulging pending legal debts -

The nominee informed the committee as follows, that –

a) She will establish a strong and robust legal department to reduce the number of outsourced counsel.

- b) She will put in place robust monitoring mechanisms to ensure cases are followed through and closely monitored to avoid losses to the County.
- V. As to How many cases she has won and impact of the cases on the public good-

The nominee stated as follows, that -

- a) She has been engaged in various litigations with great impact on the public good, notably the Sinai fire case.
- b) She ensured that victims of the tragedy got justice.
- VI. On whether the Sinai Fire case was a precursor for her nomination, seeing as the then Senator of Nairobi City County, who is now H.E. the Governor, was the only petitioner in that case –

The nominee stated as follows, that –

- a) She had initially taken up the matter on her own motion because her own relatives were affected by the tragedy.
- b) She was later asked to bring up the matter in Court by the then Senator, Hon. Mike Sonko.
- VII. With Regard to the Relationship between the nominee and the Governor in terms of work post the Sinai case -

Nominee observed that she has since been retained by the Governor as Legal Counsel.

VIII. On whether she has visited City Hall in the Past, and if aware how the former County Attorney exited office, and who is acting County Attorney and whether she has advised the Governor as legal counsel in any capacity:

The nominee stated as follows, that –

- a. She is not sure how her predecessor vacated office.
- b. As far as she knows there is currently no acting County Attorney.

- c. The Governor has a legal adviser.
- d. The Governor of Nairobi City County has never sought legal counsel regarding the affairs of the County government from her.

IX. On how she will deal with the emotive land issues and her role in providing legal counsel –

The nominee stated as follows, that -

- a. She has passion for justice, her biggest motivator for applying for the position.
- b. She would love to see property owners who lost their property unfairly through collusion between unscrupulous County Government staff and fraudsters get back their property.
- c. She will endeavor to stop collusion between employees and fraudsters to defraud genuine land owners of their property.

X. With respect to dealing with Pressure from family and friends -

The nominee stated as follows, that -

- a. She would act professionally and within the confines of the law in dealing with pressures from family and friends for favors.
- b. Accordingly, she will rely on due procedure in dealing with friends should such arise and will not participate in facilitating illegal favors.
- XI. As to her Past experience that demonstrated adherence to ethics and integrity presently under Chapter Six of the Constitution -

The nominee stated as follows, that -

- a) She has had various instances where she stood firm against graft and bribery in her legal practice.
- b) She has always been guided by integrity values throughout her life and work.
- XII. On Navigating the relationship between the Office of the County Attorney and the County Assembly -

The nominee informed the Committee that she is committed to ensuring a good working relationship with the County Assembly – for instance to ensure efficient processing of bills and publication of Acts.

XIII. As to whether the Office she has been nominated can function independently and how she will maintain that Independence in providing legal counsel -

The nominee stated as follows, that -

- a) She will ensure the independence of the office of the County Attorney is maintained.
- b) She will strive to remain neutral and provide impartial legal counsel in her own words, *call a spade a spade*.

XIV. On Navigating the relationship between her office and CECMs and Governor in providing legal counsel -

The nominee stated as follows, that -

- a) She will maintain a neutral position and provide proper legal counsel to all Departments and office of the Governor.
- b) Should wrangles arise between ministries/departments and the governor's office, she will stick to the law and not take sides in providing prudent legal counsel.
- XV. As to her participation in Community Service and whether the nominee runs any charitable activities -

The nominee informed the committee that she does pro bono work with COVAW as indicated in her resume.

XVI. Regarding What residents can expect from her if appointed -

The nominee informed the Committee that her passion for justice will ensure she delivers justice for residents.

XVII. Whether she will cancel contracts entered into by her predecessors if illegally entered:

The nominee informed the Committee that she will void contracts signed before her appointment if illegalities were committed when signing, or seek to amend the terms – if contrary to the law.

XVIII. On what in the nominee's opinion constitutes a Conflict of interest

The nominee informed the Committee that a Conflict of interest may arise if one has interest in a particular matter while sitting to decide on the same.

XIX. Regarding court Cases Between Arms Of County Government And Lose Of Monies In Litigation: -

The nominee stated that she will ensure issues are resolved amicably to avoid costly litigation between the two arms of the County Government.

XX. On how she will work with the National government to ensure County laws do not conflict with National legislation, and that National government doesn't usurp powers of the county -

The nominee informed the Committee that she will liaise with the Attorney General to advise the National Government so issues are sorted out amicably between the two levels of government without much litigation as has been in the past.

XXI. On the payment of debts owed to the County by the National Government, and whether she will explore partnerships for the National government to take up certain functions as part of debt clearance -

The nominee stated that she would be open to consultations with the Attorney General on the best way to go about settling the debts owed to the County by the National government.

5.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

The Committee makes the following recommendation: -

4.0 COMMITTEE'S OBSERVATIONS AND FINDINGS

The Committee having considered the nominees' curriculum vitae and heard their oral submissions during the vetting exercise made the following observations and findings:-

4.1 Committee Observations

The Committee having considered the nominee's filled Questionnaires pursuant to the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act No. 5 of 2017, her Curricula Vitae and having heard her oral submissions during the vetting exercise/interview made the following observations:

THAT: -

- 1. The nominee satisfies the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya on Leadership and Integrity in that:
 - a) The nominee has been cleared by the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC), Directorate of Criminal Investigations (DCI), Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA), Higher Education Loans Board (HELB) and the Credit Reference Bureau (CRB);
 - b) The nominee has not been charged in a Court of Law; and
 - c) The nominee does not exhibit a potential conflict of interest.
- 2. The nominee meets the requirements of Section 5 of the Nairobi City County Office of the County Attorney Act, 2016 since she exhibited impressive knowledge of topical and legal issues touching on the office of the County Attorney and has the requisite abilities, qualifications and experience.

Therefore, the Committee found the nominee for the Office of the County Attorney suitable for appointment as County Attorney, having met both the Constitutional and the statutory requirements.





XXII. Regarding her perceptions of the County Assembly:

The nominee stated as follows, that;

- a. She believes the Assembly plays a critical role and deserves as much respect as possible.
- b. She wasn't aware of any bad public perceptions of the Nairobi City County Assembly, and would defend the County assembly if called upon after analyzing the facts if the Assembly were maligned.

XXIII. With respect to her Sources of Income, net worth and whether she is corrupt-

The nominee informed the Committee as follows, that -

- a) Her net worth is about Kshs50 million.
- b) She has never been involved in corruption or bribery.
- c) She has never been charged or indicted for any graft or corruption in all her years of service.

MIN. NO./SCA/005/2018:- REVIEW OF DRAFT REPORT - OBSERVATIONS AND FINDINGS

- The Chairperson reiterated to the Committee that having received written and oral submissions from the nominees for CECM Finance and County Attorney, the Committee had retreated in order to write its final report on the vetting.
- The Committee reviewed the submitted information by the nominees contained in the draft report and made the following observations and findings:-

A. General observations and findings

THAT: -

- 1. Both the nominee for County Executive Committee Member Responsible for Finance and Economic Planning, and the nominee for the Office of the County Attorney, satisfy the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya on Leadership and Integrity which is a requirement under section 35(3)(c) of the County Governments Act, 2012 in that:
 - a) The nominees have been cleared by the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC), Directorate of Criminal Investigations (DCI), Kenya Revenue Authority (KRA), Higher Education Loans Board (HELB) and the Credit Reference Bureau (CRB);
 - b) The nominees have not been charged in a Court of Law; and
 - c) The nominees do not exhibit a potential conflict of interest.
- 2. Both the nominee for County Executive Committee Member Responsible for Finance and Economic Planning, and the nominee for the Office of the County Attorney meet the requirements of Section 35(3)(d) since they exhibited impressive knowledge of topical and legal issues touching on their respective dockets and have the requisite abilities, qualifications and experience.

Therefore, the Committee found the nominee for County Executive Committee Member Responsible for Finance and Economic planning, and the nominee for the Office of the County Attorney suitable for appointment as Member of the County Executive Committee and County Attorney respectively, both having met both the Constitutional and the statutory requirements.

- g) He has never been charged in a Court of Law, has no potential conflict of interest, and has fully complied with his tax obligation and other relevant clearances from state agencies as required.
- h) He has never been dismissed from office for contravention of the provisions of Article 75 of the Constitution which deals with conduct of state officers that are adversely mentioned in any investigatory report of Parliament or any Commission of Inquiry.
- i) The Committee found the nominee <u>suitable</u> and qualified for appointment as the County Executive Committee Member Responsible for the Finance and Economic Planning Sector.

COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

AND NOMINEE FOR OFFICE OF THE

COUNTY ATTORNEY

The Chairperson briefed the Committee on the vetting exercise as follows: -

THAT: -

- The Approval Hearing was held pursuant to Section 7 of the Public Appointments (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2017 and was the culmination of a process that began with the Nairobi City County Governor's nomination of Mr. Newton Munene for appointment as Member of the County Executive Committee responsible for Finance and Mrs. Lydia Kwamboka for appointment as County Attorney.
 - Standing Order 196 provides variedly for the mandate of the Committee on approval of Public Appointments.
 - It is on the basis of the foregoing that the Committee had gathered to consider the nomination of Mr. Newton Munene and Mrs. Lydia Kwamboka and their suitability for the position nominated.
 - The vetting process would be guided by the provisions of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, the Public Appointments (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2017, the County Governments Act, 2012, the Nairobi City County Office of the County Attorney Act, 2016 for the County Attorney and the Assembly Standing Orders.
 - The Assembly received a letter from the Governor dated 10th April, 2018 nominating **Mr. Newton Munene** as County Executive Committee Member responsible for Finance, Nairobi City County, and another dated 5th April, 2018 nominating **Mrs. Lydia Kwamboka** as County Attorney.
 - The Speaker conveyed the Messages to the Assembly and directed the relevant Committee, being this Committee, to take up the vetting process.

- The Assembly subsequently placed an advertisement in the local dailies on Wednesday 11th April, 2018, specifically the Standard Newspaper and the Nation Newspapers inviting the nominee for vetting before the Assembly Select Committee on Appointments on Thursday 19th April, 2018 at 9.00am at the Assembly Precincts.
- In the advertisement, the nominee was asked to carry original copies of the following documents with him for the vetting exercise, namely
 - i. Curriculum vitae;
 - ii. Academic Certificates and testimonials;
 - iii. Certificate of Good Conduct from the Police;
 - iv. Clearance from the Higher Education Loans Board;
 - v. Clearance from the Kenya Revenue Authority;
 - vi. Clearance from the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission;
- The Chair subsequently guided that the session shall proceed as follows -
 - ✓ The nominee will first take an oath
 - ✓ We shall do introductions for the Committee/nominee
 - ✓ The Committee will review the nominee's documents, and hear from the nominee and cross examine him on Oath.
 - ✓ Members will then have time to ask questions and further cross examination.
- Pursuant to Section 8 of the Public Appointments (County Assembly Approval) Act, 2017, the Committee would also be looking at the following in summary
 - (i) the procedure used to arrive at the nominee;
 - (ii) any constitutional or statutory requirements relating to the office in question; and
 - (iii) the suitability of the nominee for the appointment proposed having regard to whether the nominee's abilities, experience and qualities meet the needs of the body to which nomination is being made.

XIII. As to whether the Office she has been nominated can function independently and how she will maintain that Independence in providing legal counsel-

The nominee stated as follows, that -

- a) She will ensure the independence of the office of the County Attorney is maintained.
- b) She will strive to remain neutral and provide impartial legal counsel in her own words, *call a spade a spade*.

XIV. On Navigating the relationship between her office and CECMs and Governor in providing legal counsel -

The nominee stated as follows, that -

a) She will maintain a neutral position and provide proper legal counsel to all Departments and office of the Governor.

b) Should wrangles arise between ministries/departments and the governor's office, she will stick to the law and not take sides in providing prudent legal counsel.

XV. As to her participation in Community Service and whether the nominee runs any charitable activities -

The nominee informed the committee that she does pro bono work with COVAW as indicated in her resume.

XVI. Regarding What residents can expect from her if appointed -

The nominee informed the Committee that her passion for justice will ensure she delivers justice for residents.

XVII. Whether she will cancel contracts entered into by her predecessors if illegally entered:

The nominee informed the Committee that she will void contracts signed before her appointment if illegalities were committed when signing, or seek to amend the terms – if contrary to the law.

XVIII. On what in the nominee's opinion constitutes a Conflict of interest

The nominee informed the Committee that a Conflict of interest may arise if one has interest in a particular matter while sitting to decide on the same.

XIX. Regarding court Cases Between Arms Of County Government And Lose Of Monies In Litigation: -

The nominee stated that she will ensure issues are resolved amicably to avoid costly litigation between the two arms of the County Government.

XX. On how she will work with the National government to ensure County laws do not conflict with National legislation, and that National government doesn't usurp powers of the county -

The nominee informed the Committee that she will liaise with the Attorney General to advise the National Government so issues are sorted out amicably between the two levels of government without much litigation as has been in the past.

XXI. On the payment of debts owed to the County by the National Government, and whether she will explore partnerships for the National government to take up certain functions as part of debt clearance -

The nominee stated that she would be open to consultations with the Attorney General on the best way to go about settling the debts owed to the County by the National government.

XXII. Regarding her perceptions of the County Assembly:

The nominee stated as follows, that;

- a. She believes the Assembly plays a critical role and deserves as much respect as possible.
- b. She wasn't aware of any bad public perceptions of the Nairobi City County Assembly, and would defend the County assembly if called upon after analyzing the facts if the Assembly were maligned.

XXIII. With respect to her Sources of Income, net worth and whether she is corrupt-

The nominee informed the Committee as follows, that –

- a) Her net worth is about Kshs50 million.
- b) She has never been involved in corruption or bribery.
- c) She has never been charged or indicted for any graft or corruption in all her years of service.
