The House met at 2.30 p.m.

PRAYERS

Hon. Temporary Deputy Speaker: We don't have a quorum. I direct the Serjeant-At-Arms to ring the bell for the next 10 minutes.

(Quorum bell rings)

Still there is no quorum, we lack about 20 Members and I direct the Serjeant-At-Arms to ring the bell for the next 5 minutes.

(Quorum bell rings)

Hon. Members, still there is no quorum Standing Order 31 (1a), a quorum of the County Assembly or the Committee of the Whole Assembly should be a third of its Members. If there is no quorum present when the Chair is taken at the time appointed for the meeting of the County Assembly immediately after saying the prayer, the Speaker shall order the bell to be rang for 10 minutes and if no quorum is present at

the expiration of the 10 minutes, the Speaker may direct the bell be rang for another 5 minutes and if there is still no quorum present, the Speaker shall adjourn the County Assembly forthwith to the next sitting.

Hon. Jacqueline Nyang'ala (Nominated Member): Mr. Speaker I am sorry, we just pre-empted what you are going to say. So we got up for you to say what you were going to say.
