Tuesday 30th April 2024

The House met at 2.30 p.m.

[The Deputy Speaker (Hon. Paul Kados) in the Chair]

PRAYER

QUORUM

Hon. Deputy Speaker: Clerk, do we have quorum?

(Clerk-at-the-Table confirmed there was no quorum)

Hon. Members, since there is no quorum, pursuant to Standing Order 37 (2), I direct the Serjeant-at-Arms to ring the Bell for 10 minutes.

(Quorum Bell was rung)

(Several Members stood at the Bar)

Serjeant-at-Arms, make sure every Member is seated, please. I want all those Members to clear the door!

(The Members entered the Chamber)
