REQUEST FOR STATEMENT REGARDING IRREGULAR DESIGNATION OF OFFICERS IN THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE

Hon. Temporary Speaker: Hon. Redson.

Hon. Redson Onyango: Hon. Speaker, pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order No. 47(2) (c), I wish to request a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare regarding alleged irregular designation of officers in the County Executive.

Hon. Speaker, the Public Service Policy and Human Resource Manual set's out procedures for recruitment, designation, re-designation, deployment and re-deployment of officers in public service and the accompanying terms and benefits. Before being deployed to any area of responsibility, officers are required to meet certain academic and professional criteria.

Hon. Speaker, in the Accounts Department, for instance, there is an officer by the name Mr. Dennis Mwanzia who is responsible for preparation and processing of work plans, but his qualifications to undertake such a level of duty do not meet the requirements of the said position.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

1. The qualification of the current officer responsible for preparation of work plans, and whether the officer meets the academic and professional requirements for the said position;
2. How long has the officer served in the said position; and
3. What are the requisite procedures that need to be followed before officers are re-deployed from one office or area of responsibility to another?

Hon. Redson Onyango: I have another Statement.

Hon. Temporary Speaker: Let me commit that to Chair of Chairs.

Hon Paul Kados: Hon Speaker, I would request that the Hon Member gives us two weeks after the constitution of that committee, Hon Speaker.

REQUEST FOR STATEMENT REGARDING POSITION OF CHIEF SECURITY
AND COMPLIANCE CURRENTLY BEING HELD IN ACTING CAPACITY

Hon. Redson Onyango: Hon Speaker, pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order No. 47 (2) (c), I wish to request a Statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labour and Social Welfare regarding the position of the Chief Security and Compliance which is currently being held in an acting capacity by Ms. Eva Wangeci.

Hon. Speaker, the office of the Chief Security and Compliance is a critical position within the County Public Service and requires adherence to the applicable statutory provisions governing appointments to public office.

Hon. Speaker, despite clear legal provisions the said office has remained under an acting appointment for a period exceeding six months raising serious concerns regarding compliance with the law and effective administration.

Further, Ms. Eva Wangeci continues to perform the functions of the Chief Security and Compliance without having been vetted and approved by the County Assembly as required for appointment to such an office. This situation raises concerns as to whether the continued occupancy of the office in an acting capacity is lawful and consistent with the principles of good governance.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:

1. A detailed report on the circumstances under which Ms. Eva Wangeci was appointed to act as Chief Security and Compliance, including the date of her appointment and the legal basis for the same;
2. Whether the County Executive has initiated the process of substantively filling the position; and
3. The reasons for the delay in forwarding the nominee for the position to the County Assembly for vetting and approval.

Hon. Temporary Speaker: Chair of Chairs, please.
