# **NOTICES**

## **The Assembly resolved on Wednesday, February 14, 2018 as follows:-**

- I. **THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 103(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any Motion, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner:-A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.

## **The Assembly resolved on Thursday, February 15, 2018 as follows:-**

- II. **THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 103(4), this Assembly orders that, the debate on any Motion for the Adjournment of the Assembly to a day other than the next normal Sitting Day in accordance with the Calendar of the Assembly, be limited to a maximum of three (3) hours with not more than five (5) minutes for each Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of ten (10) minutes each; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, in that order. Provided that, when the period of Recess proposed by any such motion does not exceed ten (10) days, the debate shall be limited to a maximum of thirty minutes (30), and shall be strictly confined to the question of the adjournment.

# **NOTICE PAPER I**

## **Tentative business for Tuesday, 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2018**

*(Published pursuant to Standing Order 39(1))*

IT IS NOTIFIED that the Assembly Business Committee, at their last meeting, approved the following ***tentative*** business to appear in the Order Paper for Tuesday, April, 10, 2018:-

### **A. MOTION – HON. OSMAN ADOW, MCA**

**THAT**, aware that solid waste management in the County pose a great environmental and health challenge; **FURTHER AWARE** that Paragraph (2)(g) of part two of the Forth Schedule of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 provides for refuse removal, refuse dumps and solid waste disposal as a County function; **CONCERNED** that the implementation of solid waste management faces numerous challenge especially from the residential areas due to lack of a proper designated area for holding solid waste; **FURTHER CONCERNED** that improper solid waste management is an emerging health threat to the residents of Nairobi County, the environment and well-being of the city; **ACKNOWLEDGING** that solid waste management is a collective responsibility that requires all the generators to ensure the environment free from Health risk; **NOTING** that most residential Buildings and Estates in the County have no designated waste collection and holding area; this Assembly urges the County Executive to ensure all building plans with more than 4 stories to incorporate solid waste management chutes in their architectural plans and building with less than 4 stories to incorporate a designated solid waste holding area for temporary collection henceforth.
