## I. GOVERNOR'S RESERVATIONS TO THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY APPROPRIATION BILL, 2020 (ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 6 OF 2020)

**Notice** is given that the Leader of Majority Party intends to move the following amendments in respect of the reservations contained in the Governor's Memorandum to the Nairobi City County Appropriation Bill, 2020 (Assembly Bill No. 6 Of 2020) at the Committee Stage -

### **GENERAL**

**THAT**, the budget be rationalized to ensure that the budget is balanced to our projected revenues of Kshs 31,631,632,618.

### **SCHEDULE**

**THAT**, vote 5328: Nairobi Metropolitan Services be deleted in its entirety.

**THAT**, votes 5315 – Health, 5316 – Urban Planning and Lands, 5317 – Public Works, Transport & Infrastructure, 5323 – Environment, Water, Energy & Natural Resources, 5324 – Urban Renewal & Housing be each with two Programmes namely:

- a. Programme 1: General Administration & Support Services.
- b. Program 2: Transferred Services.

**THAT**, the Inspectorate budget allocated to Nairobi Metropolitan Services be deleted and the funds be allocated under vote R5312: Programme 0724005310: Security and safety Management and the amount determined for transfer to appropriate under sub-item 2640499 Other Current Transfers and 2640599 Other Capital Grants and Recurrent and Capital expenditure respectively.

**THAT**, in rationalizing the budget, the Items Referred in Item No 7 be restored as earlier proposed.

**I. The Assembly resolved on Wednesday, 19<sup>th</sup> February, 2020 as follows: -**

- a) **THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 103(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on **Bills** sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party be limited as follows:- A maximum of forty five (45) minutes for the Mover, in moving and fifteen minutes (15) in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee (if the Bill is not sponsored by the relevant Committee), and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each (if the Bill is not sponsored by either of them); and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
