I. The Assembly resolved on Tuesday, 21st February, 2023 as follows: -

- a) **THAT**, each speech in a debate on a **Bills NOT** sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party be limited as follows:- A maximum of three hours and thirty minutes, with not more than thirty (30) minutes for the Mover, in moving and ten (10) minutes in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.

IT IS NOTIFIED that the Select Committee on Assembly Business, at its last meeting, approved the following ***tentative*** business to appear in the Order Paper for Tuesday, 17th October, 2023 at 2.30 p.m.: -

A. MOTION – HON. PETER JATESO IMWATOK, MCA – MAJORITY LEADER

Subject: *Operationalization of the Sports Fund*

THAT, aware that Paragraph 4 (h) of Part 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya (2010) mandates County Governments with the responsibility of managing sports activities and facilities; **FURTHER AWARE** that, the Nairobi City County Assembly enacted the Nairobi City County Sports Management Act, 2017 to provide for the management, promotion and regulation of sports in the County; **NOTING** that, Section 11 of the said Act provides for the establishment of the Sports Fund whose purpose amongst others is to fund the training, research, development and capacity building of sports activities in accordance with the Sports Plan contemplated under Section 8 of the said Act; **CONCERNED** that, despite these clear provisions of the law, the County Executive is yet to establish the Sports Fund to support sporting activities in the County as envisioned in the Act thus hampering the development of sports; **FURTHER CONCERNED** that, sporting teams that represent the County in various national competitions have been turned into beggars depending on well-wishers which is not only heartbreaking but humiliating as well; this Assembly **RESOLVES** that the County Executive:-

- i) Operationalize the Sports Fund as envisioned under Sections 10 and 11 of the Nairobi City County Sports Management Act, 2017 and further that the funds be utilized in supporting sporting teams in the County;
- ii) Factors monies in the Budget Estimates for the FY 2024/25 for purposes of the Fund; and
- iii) Develops and submit to the County Assembly Regulations contemplated under Section 16 of the said Act within three (3) months of adoption of this Motion. The regulations should amongst other things provide for the management of the Sports fund.
