The Nairobi City County Food Safety and Fortification Bill, 2023 (Assembly Bill No.10 of 2023)

(Committee of the Whole County Assembly)

<u>NOTICES</u>

I. NOTICE is given that the Chairperson of the Sectorial Committee on Health Services intends to move the following amendments to the Nairobi City County Food Safety and Fortification Bill 2023, at the Committee Stage: -

LONG TITLE

THAT, the Long Title of the Bill be amended by deleting the numerical "2023" and substituting thereof with "2024".

SHORT TITLE

THAT, the **Short Title** of the Bill be amended by deleting the numerical "2023" and substituting thereof with "2024".

CLAUSE 2

THAT, Clause 2 of the Bill be amended as follows; -

- (i) In the definition of the term 'authorized officer' by inserting the words "public health" immediately after the words "chief officer"
- (ii) By inserting a new definition as follows:

"Authority means 'A public body having administrative powers on public health matters"

(iii)By deleting the definition of the word "Director" and replacing it thereof with the new definitions as follows:

"Director means 'the director Public Health"

CLAUSE 3

THAT, Clause 3 of the Bill be amended by inserting a new paragraph immediately after paragraph (e) as follows: -

(fA) Enhance public awareness on food safety and fortification'

CLAUSE 5

THAT, Clause 5 of the Bill be amended as follows; -

- (i) In Sub-clause (4) by deleting the word 'county cabinet' and replacing it thereof with the word 'County Executive Committee'
- (ii) In Sub-clause (6) by inserting the word 'public' immediately after the word 'officer'

CLAUSE 6

THAT, Clause 6 of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) In the heading by inserting the word 'public' immediately after the word 'director'

- (ii) In sub-clause (1) by inserting the word 'public' immediately after the word 'director'
- (iii)In sub-clause (1) paragraph (b) by deleting the words 'and fortification'
- (iv)In sub-clause 1 paragraph (c) by deleting it in its entirety.
- (v) In sub-clause 3 by deleting the word 'a reasonable time' and replacing it thereof with the words 'seven days'
- (vi) In sub-clause 4 paragraph (c) by deleting the word 'is willing to' and replacing it thereof with the word 'may'

CLAUSE 7

THAT, Clause 7 of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) In sub-clause (1) paragraph (f) by deleting the word 'educate and inform and replacing it thereof with the word 'sensitize'

CLAUSE 8

THAT, Clause 8 of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) In sub-clause 1 by deleting it in its entirety and replacing it thereof with a new sub-clause 1 as follows:

(1) There is established a Committee to be known as the Nairobi City County Multi-sectoral Committee on Food Safety and Fortification"

- (ii) In sub-clause 2 by deleting the words 'composed of' and replacing it thereof with the words "unincorporated and shall be comprised of"
- (iii)In sub-clause 2 by inserting a new paragraph (j) immediately after paragraph(i) as follows:
- "(iA) a representative from the Kenya Bureau of Standards"
- (iv)By adding a new sub-clause 3 immediately after sub-clause 2 paragraph (i) as follows:
- "2A) The functions of the Committee shall be to: -
- a) formulate relevant County food safety and fortification policies;
- b) implement food safety and fortification policies and regulations including but not limited to regulations on food testing and analysis, surveillance, inspection and enforcement;
- c) Develop and utilize a transparent decision-making processes based on scientific evidence on issues related to food safety and fortification;
- d) Advise the Executive Committee Member Health on matters food safety and fortification within the County.

- e) Promote food safety and fortification among stakeholders such as producers and retailers;
- f) Provide a platform for consumer sensitization on food safety and fortification; and
- g) Promote participatory capacity building for an effective County Food Safety System.
- h) Any other relevant and lawful function necessary for implementation of this Act.

CLAUSE 19

THAT, Clause 19 of the Bill be amended as follows; -

(i) In sub-clause (2) paragraph (i)

- a) by deleting the numerical "50,000" and substituting thereof with the words "Fifty Thousand"

"(c) Where it is the professional opinion of the authorized officer that any food article(s) is unfit for human consumption and can be treated, order it to be treated.

b) By inserting a new paragraph immediately after paragraph (c) as follows; (ca) Where it is the professional opinion of the authorized officer that any food article(s) is unfit for human consumption and cannot be treated, refer the matter to court for an order of destruction or deposition.

(i) In sub-clause (2)

a) By inserting the words "the goods" immediately before the word 'are"

b) By adding a new paragraph (c) immediately after paragraph (b)as follows:-"the authorized officer has obtained a court order for destruction"

- c) Uses their position to unlawfully enrich themselves or others; shall be guilty of an offence and liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding five years or to a fine not exceeding one million shillings or both.

II. The Assembly resolved on Wednesday, 14th February, 2024 as follows: -

- a) THAT, each speech in a debate on any Motion, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner:-A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
- b) THAT, each speech in a debate on Bills NOT sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party be limited as follows:- A maximum of three hours and thirty minutes, with not more than thirty (30) minutes for the Mover, in moving and ten (10) minutes in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
