8. *. MOTION – (Chairperson, Sectoral Committee on Health Services)

THAT, this Assembly adopts THE REPORT OF THE SECTORAL COMMITTEE ON HEALTH SERVICES ON INSPECTION VISIT TO KASARANI HEALTH CENTRE, laid on the Table of the Assembly on Tuesday 18th November, 2014.

9. *. MOTION – (Hon. Jaffer Kassam, MCA)

THAT, aware that County transport including county roads, traffic and parking, street lighting, public road transport is the function of County Government under Part Two of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution; further aware that recent years have witnessed an increase in the population working and residing within the Nairobi City County; concerned that several back streets in Parklands and Ngara areas have been blocked by wastepaper and bottle vendors who have turned the areas to stores for their goods; this Assembly urges the County Government to clear all the structures that have been constructed along the back streets in Parklands and Ngara areas.

NOTICE

Assembly resolved on Thursday, February 19, 2015 as follows:-

- I. THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on a Report of a Committee, a Sessional Paper or any other Report submitted to the Assembly, be limited as follows: A maximum of sixty (60) minutes for the Mover in moving and thirty (30) minutes in replying, and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, in that Order.
- II. THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any Motion, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner:- A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
