8. \*. **THE NAIROBI CITY COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT BILL, 2015 (ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 3 OF 2015)**

9. \*. **MOTION – (Hon. Karen Wanjiku, MCA)**

**THAT**, aware that Article 26 of the Constitution of Kenya (2010) gives the citizen of this Country and residents of Nairobi City County a right to life; further ware that Health Services including County Health facilities and primary health care have been devolved to the County Governments pursuant to paragraph 2 of Part Two of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution; concerned that most of the County health facilities are in deteriorating state with unavailability of enough medicine, equipment and human resource; noting good health contribute is important to a Country with future; this Assembly urges the County Government to equip all County health facilities with requisite equipment, materials, sufficient medical supplies and adequate well trained personnel to ensure that residents of Nairobi County get the required services.

**10. \*. MOTION – (Hon. Osman Adow, MCA)**

**THAT**, aware that sufficient effective transport system has a significant contribution to the economy of a country; further aware that increased public service vehicle transport has expedited the efficiency of transportation in Kenya and more so in Nairobi City County; deeply concerned that some bus stages are located at road intersections and roundabouts in various County roads, which has contributed to difficult in accessing acceleration and deceleration lanes resulting to traffic snarl-up that translates to lost man-hour by motorists especially during rush hour; this Assembly urges the County Government in conjunction with the National Government to relocate all bus stages away from road junctions and roundabouts to ease traffic within the County.

**The Assembly resolved on Thursday, February 19, 2015 as follows:-**

- I. **THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any **Motion**, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner:- A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
