THAT, aware that Article 43 (1) of the Constitution provides that every person has the right, to the highest attainable standard of health, which includes the right to health care services, including reproductive health care; deeply concerned that the attainment of the foregoing objective remains a challenge given the dire shortage of health workers within the County; noting that the County has adequate trained health professionals who are currently out of employment and whose services can help fill the gap in provision of healthcare; this Assembly urges the County Executive to –

1. Set aside a specific budget on the annual 2016/2017 Budget for the recruitment on temporary basis of additional healthcare professionals; and
2. Work in partnership with relevant medical training institutions such as the KMTC and the University of Nairobi to identify healthcare graduates who are currently out of employment for the said recruitment.

NOTICES**I. Assembly resolved on Wednesday, February 10, 2016 as follows:-**

THAT, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 94(4), this Assembly orders that, each speech in a debate on any Motion, including a Special motion be limited in the following manner:- A maximum of three hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply; and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Sectoral Committee, in that Order.
