RE: DRAFT LOCAL PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT PLANS FOR PROJECTS UNDER THE KENYA INFORMAL SETTLEMENTS IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Kenya Informal Settlements Improvement Project is a Government of Kenya project funded by the World Bank. The project is implemented in the counties through the Ministry of Transport, Infrastructure, Housing and Urban Development in conjunction with the relevant Counties.

KISIP was initiated in the year 2009, and so far Nairobi County has benefited through various interventions in the selected Informal Settlements.

Two (2No.) number settlements namely Kayole Soweto and KCC Village have been upgraded through infrastructure development i.e. roads, streetlights, solid waste plant (KCC) and storm water drainage.


A total of six (6No.) other settlements namely: Kahawa Soweto, Embakasi Village, Redeemed, Kambi Moto, Ex-Grogon and Mathare Valley Fire Victims are under the planning and survey component whereby the settlements are being planned with the aim of granting security of tenure to the beneficiaries.

The planning process has been undertaken by the consultants whereby draft reports and Local Physical Development Plans have been submitted to the county for approval. The plans will require endorsement and approval by the county assembly.
