PREPARATION OF GIS BASED GENERAL VALUATION ROLL

1.0 PURPOSE OF THE MEMORANDUM

- 1.1 The purpose of this memorandum is to request the County Executive Committee to approve the preparation of GIS based General Valuation Roll to replace the one in use which was prepared in 1980.
- 1.2 To seek for the County Executive Committee's approval of the World Bank contracted Valuers and GIS Experts to carry out the Valuation Roll.
- 1.3 To seek for the County Executive Committee's approval for gazettement of consultant Valuers and County Valuers who will be involved in the exercise
- 1.4 To seek for the County Executive Committee's approval for gazettement of Rating Area, the Nairobi City County that extents to approximately 700 sq. km.
- 1.5 To seek for the County Executive Committee's approval for gazettement of Unimproved Site Value (USV) as the Form of rating.
- 1.6 To seek for the County Executive Committee's approval for date of Valuation to be 27th June, 2016.
- 1.7 To seek for the County Executive Committee's approval for gazettement of all the above approvals in the Kenya Gazette and publication in at least one local daily.
- 1.8 To seek the County Executive Committee's assistance in fast-tracking the enactment of Valuations and Rating Bill.

2.0 BACKGROUND

Land taxation, in the form of Land rates, forms the basis of sustainable and equitable revenue source to facilitate service delivery in the County. These land taxes, which are payable annually, are based on the market value of land, which require revision on regular basis, with the law providing for ten (10) years. However the County has not been able to prepare Valuation Roll regularly, with the Roll in use currently having been done in 1980.,

Valuation Roll is a public legal document that consists of property information of all ratable properties and exempted properties within the boundaries of a rating authority produced according to legislation.

The County has been funded by the World Bank, through the Nairobi Metropolitan Services Improvement Project (NAMSIP) program, to prepare a GIS based general Valuation Roll. The contract, NO.MOLHUD/NMED/NAMSIP/CONS - 26/2014-2015, was signed on 31st May 2016 between the Ministry of Land, Housing and Urban Development and the consultants M/S Geomaps Africa and M/S Royal Valuers Ltd.. and the project commencement date was set on 27th June 2016 and as such the date of Valuation shall be 27th June, 2016.

3.0 JUSTIFICATION:

- 3.1 Valuation roll is a public legal document that consists of property information of all rateable properties within the boundaries of a rating authority produced according to legislation. The County Valuation and Rating Bill, that should govern the process is still pending enactment, as such, to commence the process, the procedures provided for in the Valuation for Rating Act Cap- 266 and the Rating Act Cap -267 laws of Kenya, shall be applied.
- 3.2 There is need to prepare a new general Valuation Roll to replace the one that is being used to levy rates which was prepared in 1980. The values of properties are as they were in 1980 denying the county the enhanced revenue.
- 3.3 The GIS based general Valuation Roll will aid in capturing up to date changes in some of the value factors, new land registrations and any other changes relating to land.
- 3.4 The current land rates billing system, involves getting land rating data from valuation offices and then entering it into rating system manually. This process is slow, cumbersome, tedious, and resource-consumptive process, prone to mistakes and irregularities. The GIS system will allow for data exchanges between the land valuation system and the land rates calculations and billing system. This will reduces leakage and gives a more robust system for billing, payment, reconciliation extra.

4.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

- 4.1 The County shall realize the enhanced revenue from land rates once the rates levied are based on the current market values that will be generated in the new Valuation Roll.
- The project is funded by the World Bank, through the NAMSIP program to the tune Kshs. 374,424,600.00 inclusive of local indirect and direct taxes.

5.0 RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The County Executive Committee is requested to:

5.1 Approve the preparation of GIS based General Valuation Roll to replace the one in

use which was prepared in 1980.
