

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Transport and Public Works regarding the status of payment of all Contractors who have completed their projects across the City particularly Ngei Ward.

Hon. Speaker, the County recently embarked on major renovation works of placing cabros on constructed roads across the City. Whereas various projects have not been implemented, some areas of the County have completed road works. For instance, Makuti road in Ngei Ward was completed in September, 2022 yet Scope Contractors who worked on the said road have never been paid for their services.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Whether the County Executive has set aside a budget to pay the said contractor;
- ii. When the said Contactor will be paid for their services;
- iii. List of all paid and unpaid contractors across the County; and
- iv. Steps that the County is taking to ensure that all pending bills are paid to the relevant contractors across the County.

## REQUEST FOR STATEMENT

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 47(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Roads, Transport and Public Works regarding the number of Matatu sacco's that have been allocated pick-up and drop-off points.

Hon. Speaker, Section 47 (1) of the Nairobi City County Transport Act, 2020 presupposes that, *a public transport vehicle shall not, without prior authority by the County, be parked in any place other than a designated public transport vehicles terminal.*

Hon. Speaker, the County has numerous designated dropping and pick-up zones across the County where both the public and private vehicles pay monthly fees to be allocated a stage to operate on a daily basis.

Hon. Speaker, there have been cases where more than two Matatu Sacco's are allocated the same dropping and pick-up zone therefore causing a havoc.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

1. The number of drop and pick-up slots for PSVs in the Central Business District;
2. A list of registered PSV SACCOS that operate from the CBD and their respective designated picking and dropping slots;
3. Whether the said SACCOS have complied with the monthly payments for dropping and pick-up allocation; and
4. Proof of payment if any by the said SACCOS.
