1.0 PREFACE: NAIROBI CITY COUNTY FISCAL STRATEGY PAPER FOR FY 2024/25

- 1.1 The Constitution of Kenya under Article 220(2) sought for National legislation regarding Counties budgeting requires that the legislation shall prescribe the structure of the development plans and budgets of counties, when the plans and budgets of the counties shall be tabled in the county assemblies; and the form and manner of consultation between the national government and county governments in the process of preparing plans and budgets.
- **1.2** The provisions of Sections 117 (1) of the Public Finance Management Act, 2012 stipulates that the County Treasury shall submit to the County Executive Committee the County Fiscal Strategy Paper for approval and the County Treasury shall submit the approved Fiscal Strategy Paper to the County Assembly, by 28th February of each year.
- 1.3 The provision of the Public Finance Management Act Section 117 (7) stipulates further that not later than 14 days after submitting the County Fiscal Strategy Paper to the County Assembly, the County Assembly shall consider and may adopt it with or without amendments.
- 1.4 The County Fiscal Strategy Paper is a vital document that underpins the county fiscal and budget framework by laying out strategic priorities and fiscal policy that is what the county plans to do regarding revenue, expenditure and debt management over the medium-term. Importantly, this document sets the sector and program resource ceilings that guide the budget estimates.
- 1.5 In conformance with the provision of Article 196 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 which dictates that a County Assembly shall; (a) conduct its business in an open manner, and hold its sittings and those of its Committees, in public; and (b) facilitate public participation and involvement in the legislative and other business of the Assembly and its Committees; the Nairobi City County Assembly undertook a public participation exercise on Thursday 7th March, 2024 in the Sub-Counties.
- 1.6 Highlights contained herein were from the submission by the public during the public participation exercise that was held in the Sub-Counties.
- 1.7 Upon conclusion of the briefing, the participants were grouped into their respective Sub Counties, where they discussed and identified key issues of priorities for consideration in the County Fiscal Strategy Paper.

The following are issues arising from the public participations:

2.0 SUBMISSION FROM THE PUBLIC ARISING OF PHYSICAL MEETINGS

2.1 Public views from Starehe and Kamukunji Sub-Counties

Members of public while meeting at Kariokor Social Hall submitted the following as their priority projects in the CFSP for FY 2024-25.

Priority areas

- 1) Provision of fully equipped ambulance.
- 2) Upgrading of Health Centers by having X-ray machines.
- 3) Conduct civic education on spread of TB, HIV and malaria and allocate funds for treatment.
- 4) Provide basic utilities in Health Centers and County Hospitals.
- 5) Construction of retail and wholesale markets at Jua Kali.
- 6) Install streetlights and enhance maintenance.
- 7) Put cabrios on pedestrian walkways and markets.
- 8) Construction of sewerage and drainages.
- 9) Upgrade to bitumen standards all roads in the Sub County.
- 10) Construction of modern kiosks.
- 11) Construction and equipping of Ward Offices.
- 12) Construction of additional ECD classes.
- 13) Provision of quality food to all learners in Primary Schools.
- 14) Construction of Vocation Training Centers.
- 15) Installation of flood lights.
- 16) Employment of more ECDE teachers.
- 17) Improvement of water supply in the Sub County.
- 18) Renovation of all County offices.
- 19) Upgrading sewer lines and unblocking drainages.
- 20) Construction of boreholes
- 21) Improvement of garbage collection.
- 22) Creation of sports recreation centers in the Wards.
- 23) Construction of innovation and business centers well equipped with Wi-Fi.

2.2 Public views from Embakasi North and Embakasi South

Members of public while meeting at Dandora Area 1 Social Hall submitted the following as their priority projects in the CFSP for FY 2024-25.

A. Dandora Area I

- 1) Construction of bridge to connect Dandora and Mwiki, Roysambu and Kayole Junction to make the area accessible.
- Construction of Library and equipping of Dandora 1 Social Hall. To tap into youth talents and reduce drug addiction.
- 3) PCEA church and Dandora Community Centre operate on an allegedly grabbed land, County should prioritize reclaiming the land and convert it to other essential Community use.
- 4) Need for County Government in consultation with the National Government to develop a master/ consolidated plan that will fully open and make Embakasi North and Embakasi West sub counties fully accessible to attract prospective investors.

- 5) Construction of social amenities on the available 7.5 acres in Dandora 1 which is currently being occupied illegally by various churches.
- 6) The Equipping of the Hospitals as resolved by the County Assembly in the ADP 2024- 25 is a good intention.
- 7) Dandora Green Light Vocational Training being a county institution should absorb more residents.
- 8) Robust tree planting program in Dandora Dumpsite be prioritized to help absorb contaminants emanating from garbage.

B. Dandora Area II

- 1) Development of legal/regulatory framework to address pollution/emissions from the dumpsite, which is choking children in James Gichuru Primary, Wangu Primary, Tom Mboya Primary schools which border the dumpsite.
- 2) Sewer blockages courtesy of residents building on the main sewer and on allegedly grabbed land.

C. Dandora Area III

1) Construction of social hall Perimeter wall.

D. Dandora Area IV

- 1) Construction of sewer infrastructure to abate perennial blockage of sewer and poor drainage.
- 2) Clearance of piles of garbage blocking the road matatus plying Route No.41 and 36 pass.

E. Kariobangi South

1) Equipped Kayole south Health center is not serving residents optimally because of alleged collusion and diversion of medical supplies by unscrupulous officers.

2.3 Public Views from Westland Sub-County

Members of the public while meeting at City Park in Westland Sub-County submitted the following as their priority projects in the CFSP for FY 2024-25.

A. Under Health, Wellness and Nutrition Sector

- 1) The ongoing projects in the sub-county be allocated sufficient resources for completion to lessen roll overs.
- 2) Regarding school feeding program, specific schools where construction of 10 centralized kitchens and 63 serving sheds be stated.

B. Under Mobility and Works Sector

- 1) High Mast/street lighting along main roads in the Sub- County roads, maintenance of roads and drainages and tarmacking of feeder roads be prioritized.
- 2) The implementation status of most of the projects in the Sub-County were said to be ongoing yet nothing or minimal work had been done.

C. Under Green Nairobi Sector

- Allocation be made to cater for regular environmental education and public sensitization to improve the public's perception towards environmental management to reduce illegal dumping waste production.
- 2) Prioritize construction of ablution blocks in City Park and Ndumbuini area.

- 3) NB: Construction of a toilet at Ndumbuini has been proposed for the last 3 Financial Years and was certainly not considered.
- 4) Funds be allocated for proper waste management in Karura.
- 5) Resources be allocated for boreholes drilling in the markets and public schools within the subcounty.

D. Under Boroughs and Sub-County Administration

- 1) The specific location where boroughs will be constructed be provided.
- 2) Channel more funds to boroughs to ensure delivery of services even closer to consumption points hence support devolution.

E. Under Business and Hustler Opportunities Sector

Members of the public proposed rehabilitation of existing markets and locations of construction of the 25 modern kiosks be provided.

F. Under Talent, Skills Development and Care

- 1) From the Kshs.829M of the development budget, completion of ECDE centers be prioritized.
- 2) Allocate sufficient funds for rehabilitation programs for the purpose of safeguarding the welfare and rights of children.

2.4 Public views from Mathare and Ruaka Sub-Counties

Members of the public while meeting at Mathare North Social Hall submitted the following as their priority's projects in the CFSP for FY 2024- 25.

A. Hospital Ward

- 1) Upendo dispensary be supplied with drugs and be equipped.

- 1) Installation of public lighting and foot bridge construction.
- 2) Construction of stalled Njathaini upper road.
- 3) Construction of Mtongwe road.
- 4) Construction of modern kiosks in the Ward.
- 5) Reclaim all grabbed lands to create space for recreational centers.
- 6) Fast track Biashara Revolving Fund and sensitize youth on the same.

C. Roysambu Ward

- 1) Construction of stalled Mugumoini storm water drainage system.
- 2) Construction of ablution block at Marurui stage.
- 3) Installation of water tank at Marurui market.
- 4) Installation of ICT infrastructure at Marurui Health Center.
- 5) Construction of Motor Able Bridge at New Njathani road.
- 6) Construction of the proposed TVET institution in Roysambu ward.
- 7) Construction of Modern kiosks in Marurui and Roysambu.
- 8) Construction of the proposed social hall.
- 9) Rehabilitation of Gathara River and development of trees nurseries.
- 10) Rehabilitation of Thome Road from Clarret to SDA church.
- 11) Upgrade Thome Shepherd road.
- 12) The following roads be upgraded; Kamiti /Kwaru bypass road, Kamae Kiwanja Road, and Rubis Kiwanja road.
- 13) Construction of Health Facility in Kamae.
- 14) Rehabilitate Kiwanja Vocational Center and upgrade it to a boarding facility.
- 15) Construction of social hall.

D. Kahawa Ward

- 1) Upgrade lower Kongo road to cabrio standard.
- 2) Upgrade Kiangishiri to cabrio standard.
- 3) Upgrade Main Rurie Road to bitumen standards.
- 4) Re-carpet main Maziwa tarmac road.

3.0 OTHER SUBMISSION OF PUBLIC MEMORANDA

The citizen of kamukunji Sub County, Nairobi County presented a memorandum with the following recommendations.

1) Review and revise the development ceilings in Health/Wellness sector to allocate adequate fund for provision of wellness centers and other health services in Kamukunji Sub County and other related sub counties.

A. Pumwani Ward

- 1) Increase the budgetary allocation for Disaster Management and Coordination and implement effective measures to prevent and respond to fire incidents in Gikomba Market and other areas prone to disasters.
- 2) Increase the number of nursing and care units for women traders in Gikomba Market and other business and hustler opportunities in Kamukunji Sub County.
- 3) Enhance the performance and accountability of Talent/Skills sector and allocate funds for improvement of sports infrastructure in Kamukunji Sub County, especially the new Kamukunji Primary School pitch.
