WE, THE UNDERSIGNED citizens of Kenya who are residents of Imara Daima Ward in Nairobi City County,

DRAW the attention of the Nairobi City County Assembly to the following;

THAT aware that Article 43 and the Fourth Schedule Part 2(2c) of the Constitution of Kenya protects every person's right to a clean and healthy environment and right to primary health care;

THAT WHEREAS Article 185 of the Constitution vests the legislative authority and oversight function at the county level on the County Assembly;

THAT WHEREAS the Kenya Health Policy (2014-2030) recognizes the rights of communities to manage their own health affairs and to further their development;

THAT WHEREAS Clause 20(o) and (p) of the Health Act, 2015 mandates the County Department of Health to engage in developing and promoting public participation in the planning and management of local health facilities so as to promote broad ownership and ensuring and coordinating the participation of communities in the governance of health services at the county level so as to promote a participatory approach in health care governance;

THAT WHEREAS the management committees of the health centers in Nairobi rights to exercise their duties and responsibilities are being hindered by the lack of gazettment by the county;

THAT WHEREAS the HFMCs play a vital role in governance of healthcare and promotion of the interests of the community through public participation in management of the health centres in Nairobi;

THAT WHEREAS one of the core mandates of the health management committees is to manage account for the hospital through which the Health Services Sector Fund is channeled, however because they are not legally gazetted they cannot act as signatories in the banks and therefore rendering them incapable of managing the account and affecting delivery of key health services;

THAT WHEREAS we note that for a period of over 1year new HFMCs have not been gazetted;











THAT WHEREAS it is noteworthy that it is a function and duty of the Nairobi County to promote primary healthcare and community public participation in Nairobi.

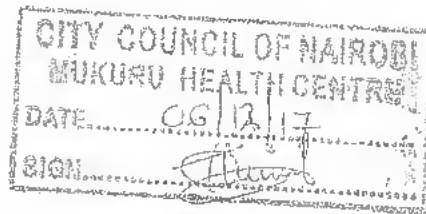
RE: GAZZETMENT OF MUKURU HEALTH CENTRE

Mukuru Health Centre is a level three health facility in Imara Daima Ward, Embakasi South Constituency. It serves a catchment population of 70,000 Kenyans. Patients seeking services at the facility mainly reside in Mukuru Kwa Njenga Ward, Pipeline ward, Kware and Imara Daima ward. The facility offers a range of primary health care services comprising of maternity services, child welfare services, nutrition services, HIV/TB services, outpatient services, pharmacy, lab and physical rehabilitation services.

Major strides have been realized in service delivery especially the commencement of maternity services in August 2015. To date,

approximately 600 babies have been delivered at the health enter. However, the facility is not gazzeted like other Nairobi City County health facilities which receive funding from HSSF(Health Sector Service Fund) and DANIDA fund. This has led to a variety of challenges in optimizing service delivery at the health centre. The HFMC(Health Facility Management Committee) which is mandated to oversee the management of the health centre is also not gazzeted. This is necessary so that the committee is carries out its mandate legally. Kindly lobby for the resolution of these challenges inorder to guarantee quality care for our patients.

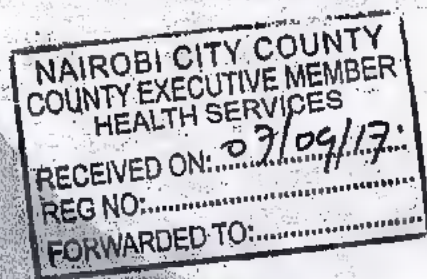
