REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Budget and Appropriations regarding the conflicting revenue figures as announced by the County Executive Committee Member for Finance and the collections by Jambo Pay.

Hon. Speaker, in terms of revenue collection, figures from the 2013, 2014, 2015 and 2016 consolidated Annual Reports for the counties by the Controller of Budget show that the county collected a total of KSh33.24 billion between the financial year 2013/14 and the financial year 2015/16, at an average of KSh11.08 billion per year, with revenues jumping to Kshs14.5 billion for the FY 2016/17, an increase of about Kshs 3 billion.

Hon. Speaker, last Tuesday, acting Finance executive Charles Kerich told journalist that the county collected Sh8.2 billion out of a target of Sh17.2 billion for FY 2017/18. Separately, JamboPay CEO Danson Muchemi reportedly told the Assembly ICT committee last Wednesday that his firm collected Sh14 billion for the county during the same financial year.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:-

- i) Exact revenues collected during the Financial Year 2017/2018;
- ii) Why there are discrepancies in the figures emanating from Jambo Pay and the County Treasury;
- iii) Measures taken to assure the public that no public monies have been lost from the above confusion; and
- iv) Measures the County has put in place to safeguard revenue collections as the contract for Jambo Pay.
