

REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Environment and Natural Resources regarding drainage and sewerage infrastructure in upper hill ward.

Hon. Speaker, the sewerage system in Upper hill ward is in a pathetic state as a result of a private developer who is in the process of erecting a forty four floor storey building and has erected a fence encroaching the roadside drainage system towards his/ her premises thereby preventing free flow of water along the road, raising fear by residents of possible cholera attack.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:-

- i) Measures put in place to avert the lurking health catastrophe;
- ii) The position of parking area within the area;
- iii) Steps put in place to improve the drainage system in this area;
- iv) Whether there is a change of user since the plot was initially residential; and
- ν) If at all there is a surrender land for road that has been forwarded to the county government.
