REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs regarding an alleged grabbed government land in Kapiti Road between High-way Secondary School and Zanzibar road.

Hon. Speaker, an unknown developer through Rabala & co. advocates has made communication through a letter dated 22nd October 2018 hereby attached in my documents compelling the current owners of kiosks constructed under the supervision of the County Government and issued with stickers along Kapiti road in Nairobi South B Ward to vacate as he intends to begin construction on his premises by 3rd of December.

Hon. Speaker, the area in question is a road reserve making it a government property. The said kiosk owners acquired the kiosks from the County Government through the agreements that are attached overleaf including photos, bank receipts showing transactions regarding the same.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i. Whether the county executive is aware of the claim by the said private developer.
- ii. Whether the land in question in the above kiosk location is a government land or a private property.
- iii. The legality of the developer to compel kiosk owners to vacate the premise; and,
- iv. Measures taken by the County Government to curb such incidences in the County.
