REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Environment and Natural Resources regarding the beautification initiative in the County.

Hon. Speaker, the effort being put in place by H.E the Governor to facelift the aesthetics of this City is laudable given that it is the capital and first point of contact of the Country by most international visitors. However, Mr. Speaker, the same must be done while taking into account the users of transport infrastructure, especially roads. This regards the concrete blocks erected at the Nyayo Stadium Roundabout that are aligned with the roads ostensibly to prevent motor vehicles from overreaching and damaging beautification installations in case of an accident.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

1. Reasons for the erection of the blocks with full knowledge of potential risks it poses to motorist's lives that are likely victims of accidents or loss of control; and
2. Measures put in place by the County Executive to prevent potential accidents in such places while undertaking the beautification process;
3. What measure the County has put in place to ensure that persons who damage public property such as lights and beautification projects are held liable to pay?
