**REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS**

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs regarding harassment of motorcycle operators.

Hon. Speaker, operators have often been found to violate County Government policies and directives, especially regarding their operation in the Central Business District leading to their arrest and confiscation of their motor bikes.

Hon. Speaker, following the recent ban, the operators held a joint meeting with the Police and County officials and resolved that:

- a) Officers from City Hall and the main yard at St. Peter's Cleavers would neither undertake separate operations on motorcyclists nor do storage of the confiscated motorcycles as it has been done before;
- b) That the County would allow the operators to operate from temporary designated stages in the City in the long term; and
- c) Motorcyclie operators would be allowed to operate without harassment on Kirinyaga, road, University Way, Uhuru Highway, Landhies and Haille Sellassie Avenue. (see minutes attached)

Hon. Speaker, in the statement the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:

- 1. Steps the County Executive has taken to ensure that motorcyclists are treated as per the agreement of the meeting with the County officials; and
- 2. Steps taken by the County Executive to provide designated zones for motorcycle operators to operate from.
