REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Water and Sanitation regarding the water rationing in the County by the Nairobi City Water and Sewerage Company Limited and blocked water pipes in the County particularly Kayole Central.

Hon. Speaker, recent years have experienced inadequate supply water across the County which has forced the Nairobi City Water and Sewerage Company Limited to ration the distribution of this important commodity.

Hon. Speaker, the residents of Kayole Central Ward are undergoing undue suffering due to inadequate water supply. This is despite the Nairobi City Water and Sewerage Company developing a schedule on rationing of water across the County. In addition, most water pipes in the area are blocked making it more difficult for the residents to access the limited water available.

Hon. Speaker, in the Statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i) Reasons for not supplying adequate water to the residents of Kayole Central Ward despite having a schedule on the same;
- ii) Measures the County Executive is taking to ensure the blocked water pipes are unblocked and when;
- iii) Measures the County Executive is taking to ensure the residents of Kayole Central and the County at large receive adequate water supply without delay.
