REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS

Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45 (2) (c), I wish to request a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs regarding the harassment of taxi drivers in Nairobi County especially in the Central Business District around Tom Mboya street.

Hon. Speaker, taxis and tuktuk driver's despite being charged for the parking fees they still undergo harassment and their vehicles being towed away from parking lots as early as 7am.

Hon. Speaker, all the revenue collection officers aided by the County inspectorate are charging more than what is provided for in the Finance Act 2018, the charges being two thousand five hundred Kenya shillings(2500ksh.) instead of one thousand Kenya shillings(1000ksh).

Hon. Speaker, in the statement the Chairperson should inquire into and report on:

- I) The continued harassment of taxis and tuktuk drivers despite their compliance with County laws and other requirements.
- II) What By-Laws or regulation is the inspectorate asking for considering by-laws are no longer in existence;
- III) Are spaces meant for taxis and tuktuk parking given to matatus illegally; and

IV) What is County Executive doing to curb the harassment of the taxi drivers concerning the parking going forward;
