## **REQUEST FOR STATEMENTS**

Subject: The status of tendering, purchase of equipment and the use of the bio-metric registration of County Staff

## Hon. Speaker,

Pursuant to Standing Order 45(2) (c), I wish to request for a statement from the Chairperson of the Sectoral Committee on Labor and Social Welfare regarding the status of procurement, registration and use of the Bio-metric register of staff of Nairobi City County government.

Hon. Speaker, it is imperative that for the government to achieve targets and provide services, the human resource should be well known to ease and aid in preparation of and job distribution. Hon. Speaker, the County, between 22<sup>nd</sup> May 2019 and 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2019, launched and undertook the bio-metric registration of all County Staff with an aim of doing away with ghost workers. Hon. Speaker, three months after the conclusion of the registration process, a report is yet to be made public.

Hon. Speaker, in the statement, the Chairperson should inquire into and report on: -

- i) The legality of the tendering process employed in acquiring the bio-metric registration equipment for the staff of the county and the contract sum awarded for the equipment;
- ii) The exact number of staff employed and already registered by the county under the system including those who have reached retirement age;
- iii) The exact number of ghost workers identified from the data collected if any;
- iv) When the citizens of and staff of the county should expect a report on the concluded exercise.
